Chaplain's Message

It's Springtime and Easter is just around the corner. With Springtime comes the most important and significant day that we as Christians celebrate. We may enjoy the Easter eggs and pretty spring flowers, but those things pale significantly as we think of the great suffering that our Lord went through as He died to give us the gift of eternal life by paying the debt for our sins. We can see Him burst forth from the grave on Resurrection morning! "He is not here. He is risen!" (Luke 24:6)

We take this gift for granted in many ways, but when we step back to think about what took place because of our sins, how can we be so easily turned to failure again? Jesus chose His disciples, including Peter and Judas. Each took the Lord's Supper together. Each had the opportunity to follow Jesus as Lord. Each failed Him. Peter "went out and wept bitterly" (Luke 22:62) and was forgiven and lived out his life in service to Jesus. But Judas went out and hanged himself.

How will you let this Easter season affect and strengthen you? We can learn from both Peter and Judas. We may love the Lord and yet fail Him. But let us lift our eyes and see the face of Jesus as Peter did when the rooster crowed and arise forgiven to live the life that He wants for us by serving Him each day, sharing this Good News, and risking the critical words people may have for us because of our faith in a Risen Savior.

When Cars Didn't All Look Alike



After world war II, 1940s and 1950s cars became lower, longer and broader in look, as well as more massive and hefty. The semi-automatic transmission was introduced by Hudson, and the driver could change between manual and semi-automatic with the push of a button.



The US-made cars offered huge trunk sizes, width and length. In the 1940s a new car cost about \$800 and a gallon of gas was about 18 cents - not a bad deal.



In the 50s, chrome was introduced to more cars and also a more luxurious look in a country slowly getting back to its feet after the war. The 1950s saw a huge boom in American car manufacturing and during that time, the U.S. made more cars than England, France, Japan, Sweden and many other nations put together - and many times over. The 50's was the decade of cars, and the huge demand saw both Ford and GM hit the 50 million car mark.

It is an 1/8 mile track, 660 ft, so speeds are between 65 and 85 depending on your completion level. It is a chance to show your old car and a chance to race it in friendly and safe surrounds. This show is separate from the drags but in theory a CCC member could enter both events.






Since it goes through DFW mid week, we could do just the 1st half of the route
