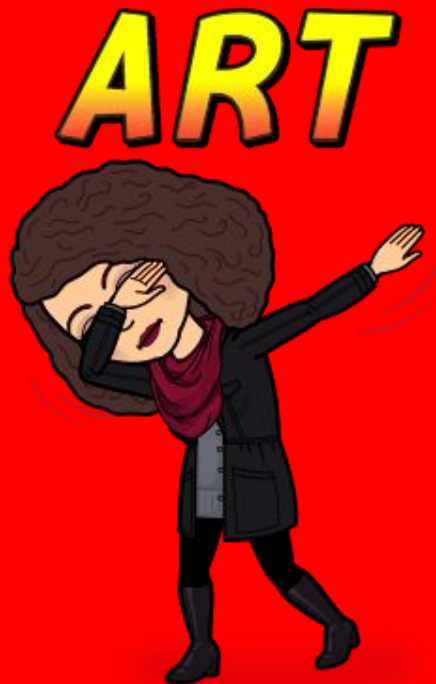

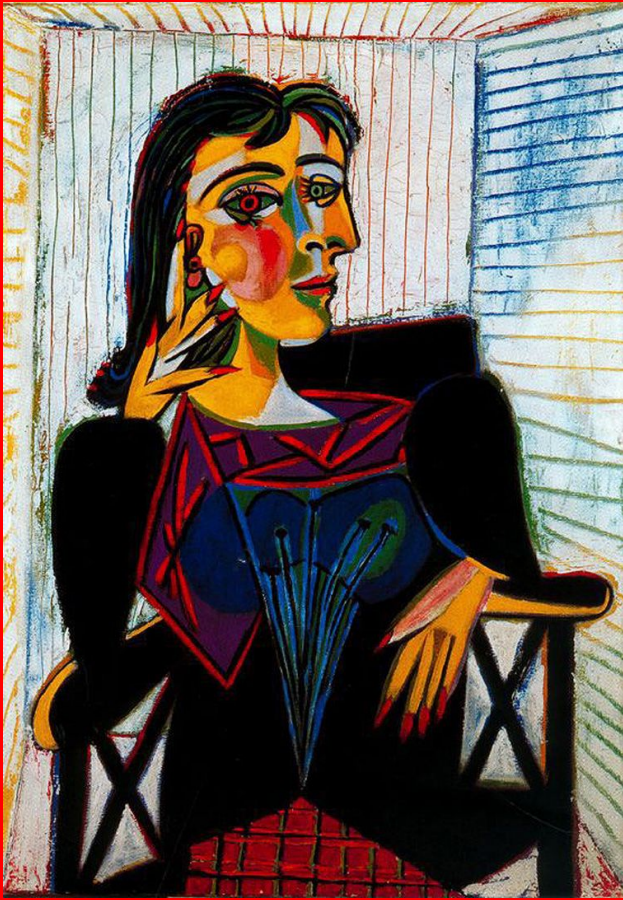

# LET'S WARM UP!

Open your sketchbook!

Start by holding your pencil in your hand and rotating your wrist 10 times each direction!

Now let's hold out our arm and rotate from the shoulder - count to ten!

CONTOUR DRAWINGS!

HAND 手

HOLD YOUR HAND  
OUT IN FRONT OF  
YOU AND DRAW IT!  
DON'T PICK UP  
YOUR PENCIL -  
KEEP IT ALL ONE  
LINE!

NOW, MAKE A FIST,

CHANGES? Which is  
easier to draw - fist or  
spread hand?

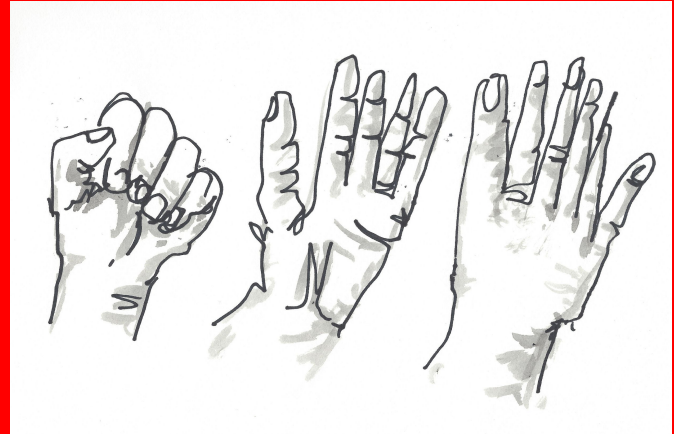
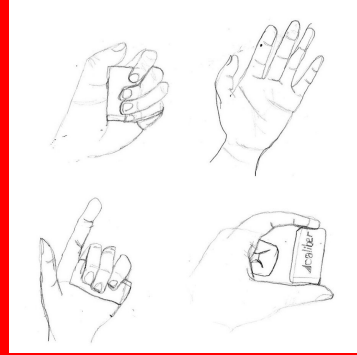




ONE MORE

HOW DID YOU DO?

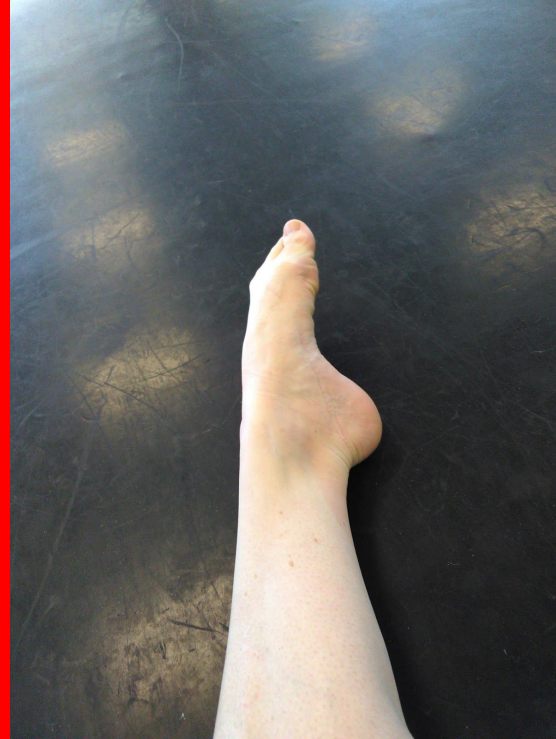


Let's try a few more!

Hold one foot out  
in front of you...

Now try flexing your  
foot!

you see?

Last week we learned about PROPORTION and EYES!

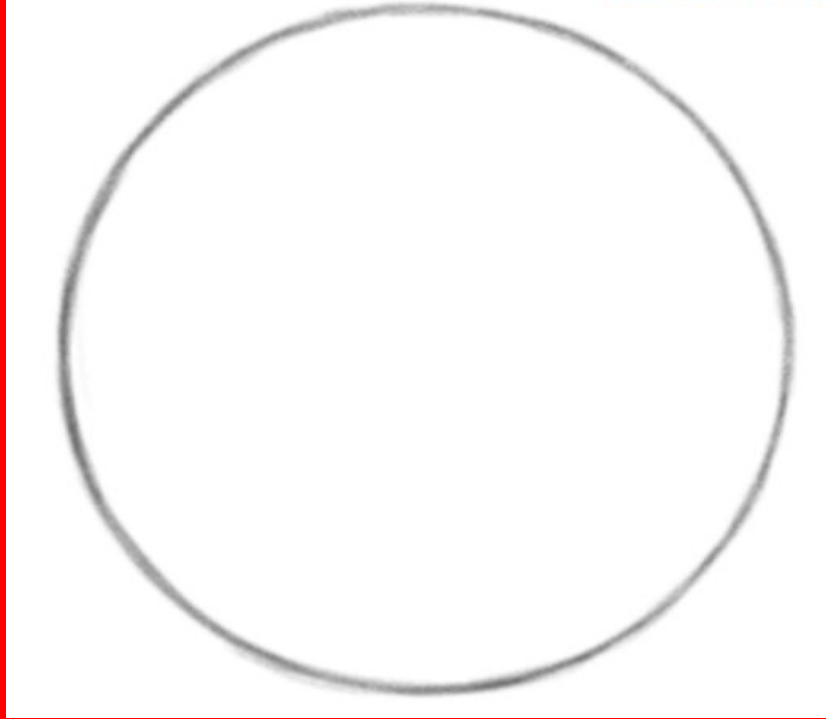
Today we will review eyes and learn a new technique based on a circle and a diagonal line!

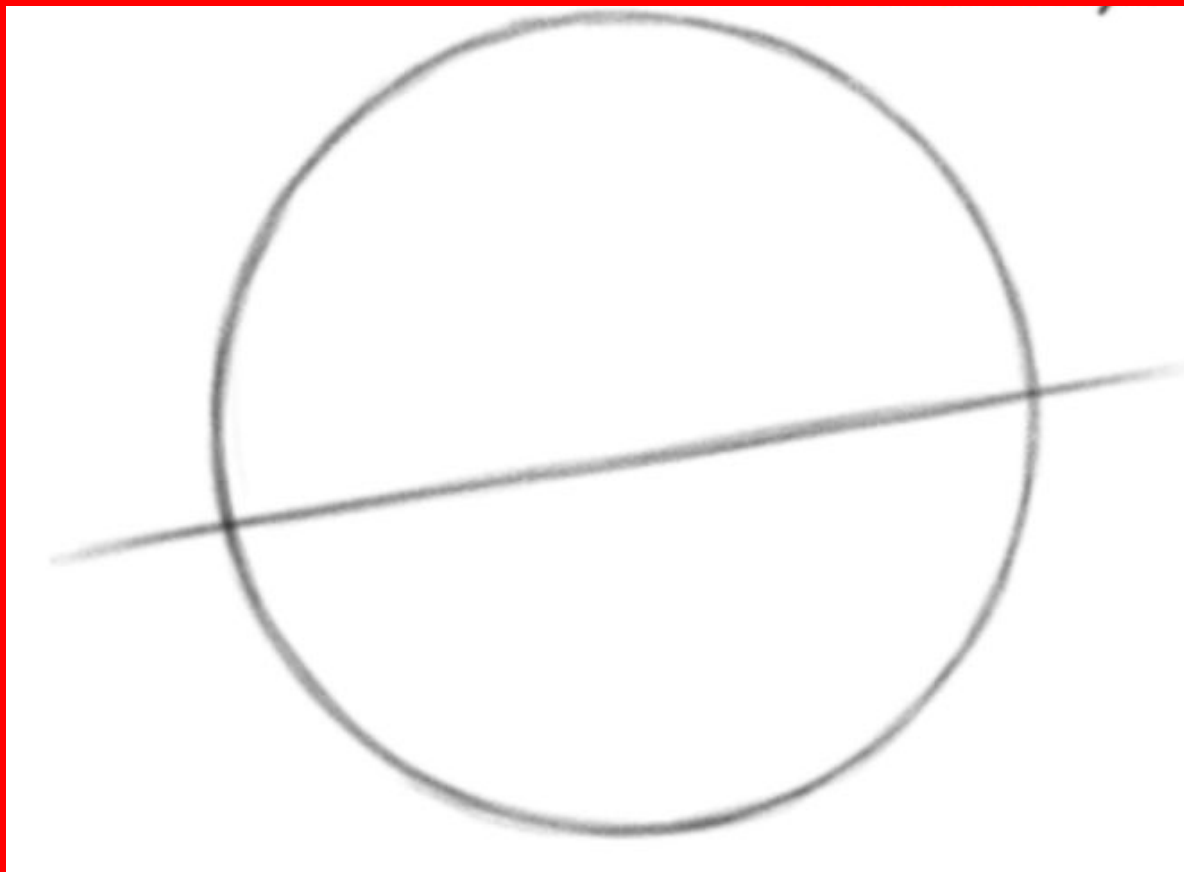
Just like people, eyes come in all shapes and sizes!



Let's go step by step again:

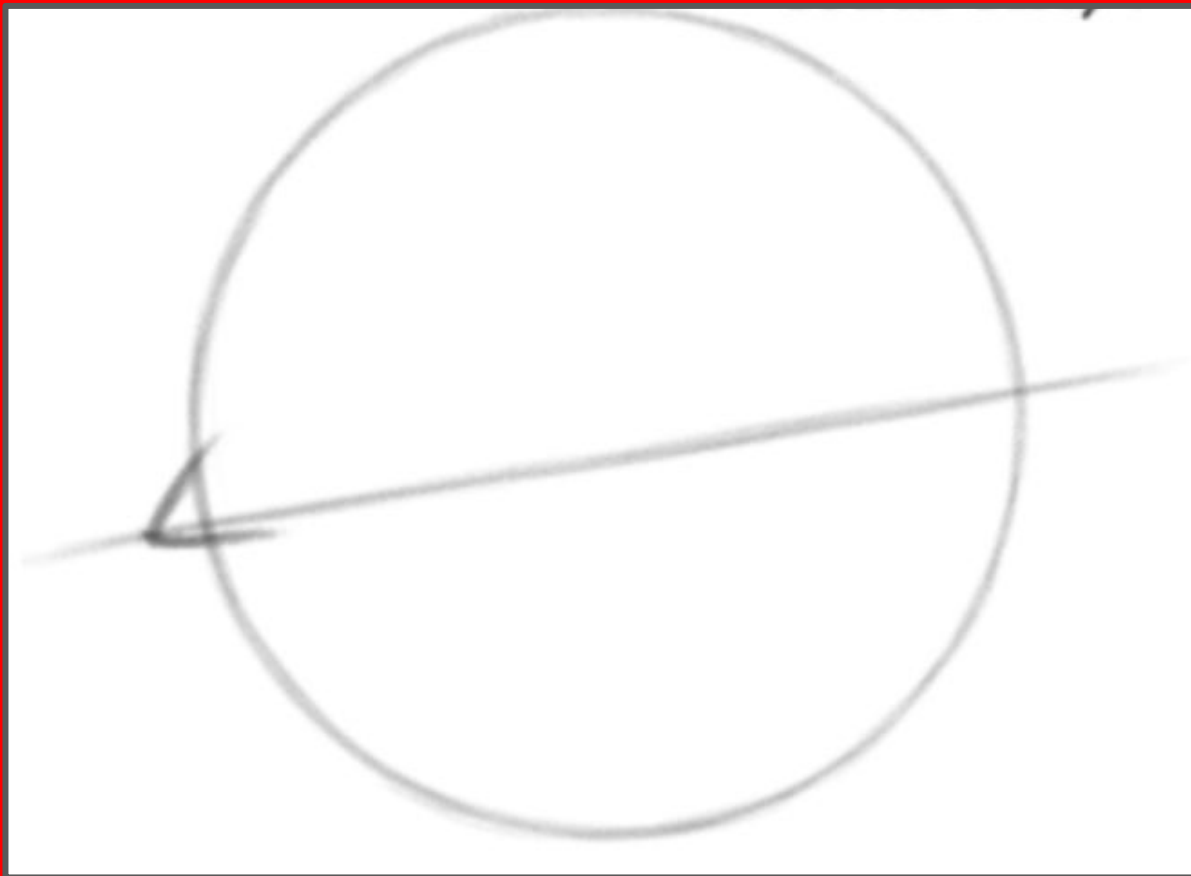
Start with a  
circle



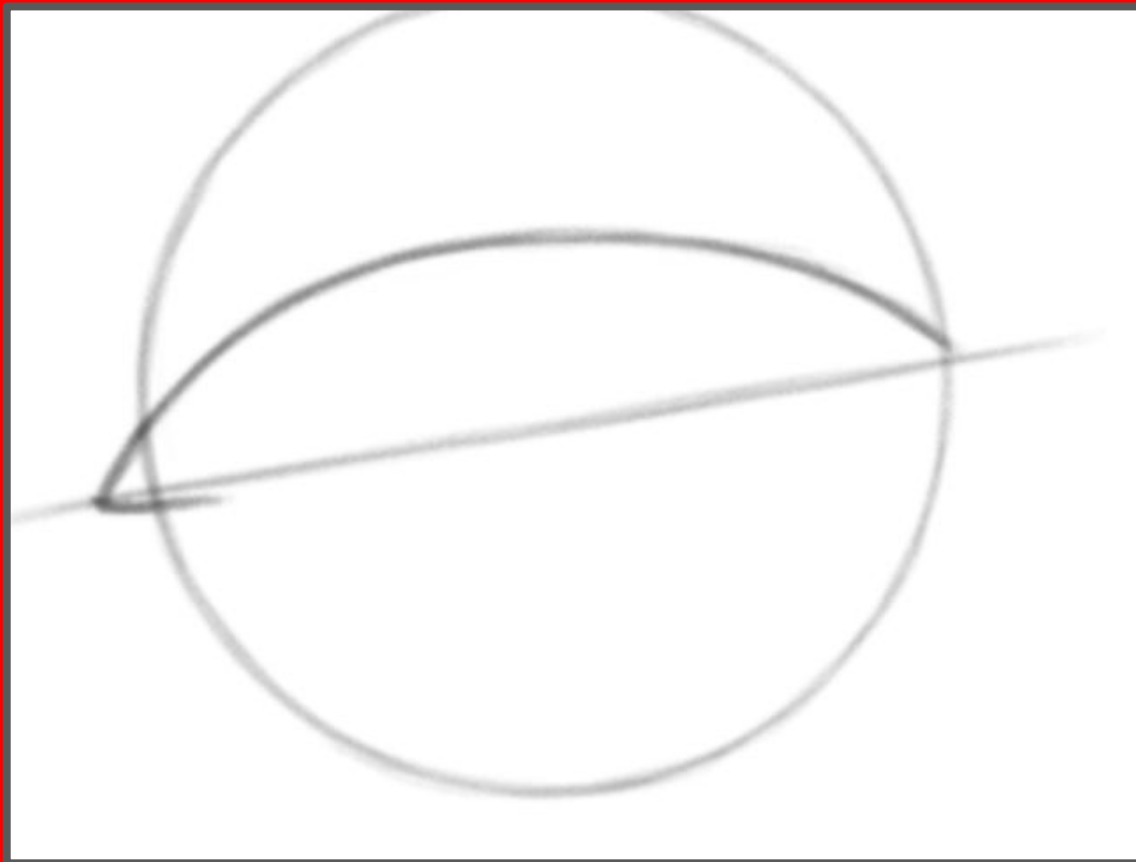


PICK YOUR  
ANGLE - this  
will define the  
corners of the  
eyes.

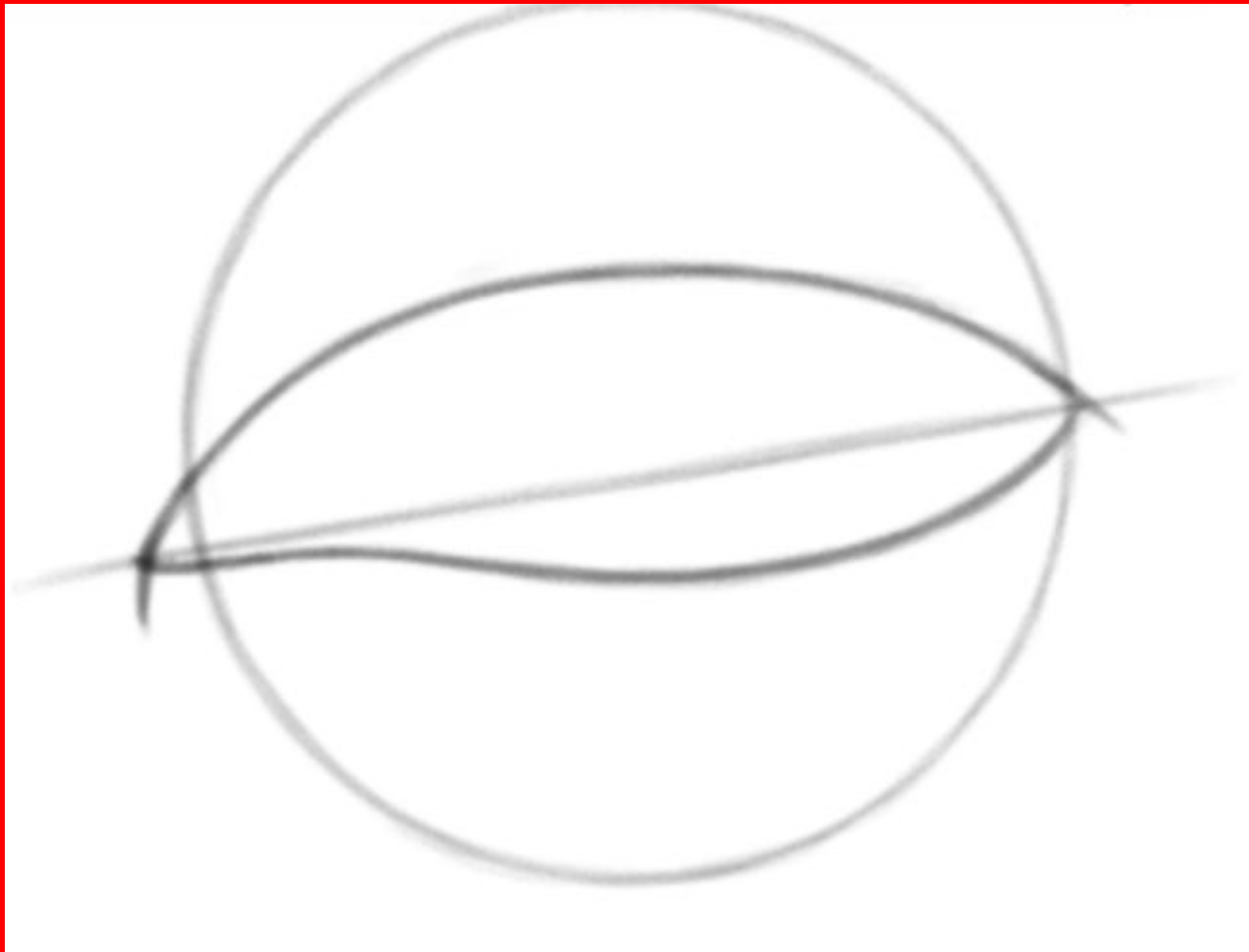
DRAW THE INNER  
CORNER OF THE  
EYE - I like to  
make a “V”



Draw the  
eyelid -  
connecting  
from corner  
to corner  
along the  
line!

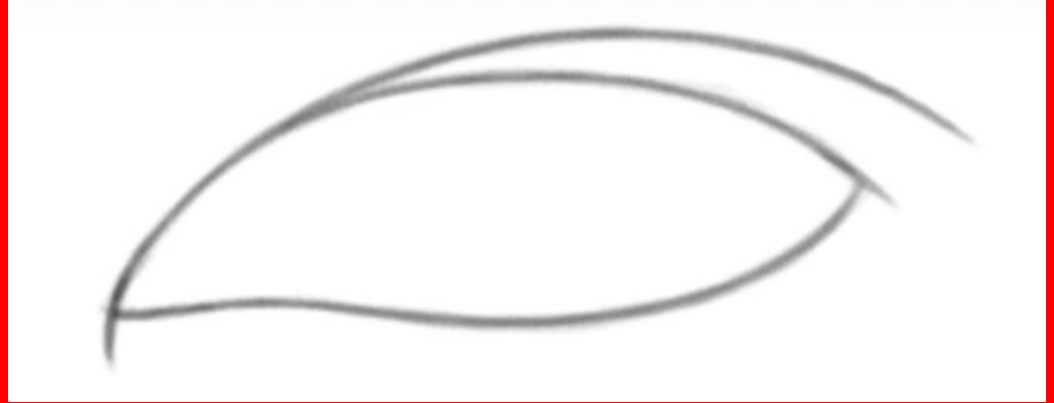


The bottom lid can  
be tricky - take your  
time!





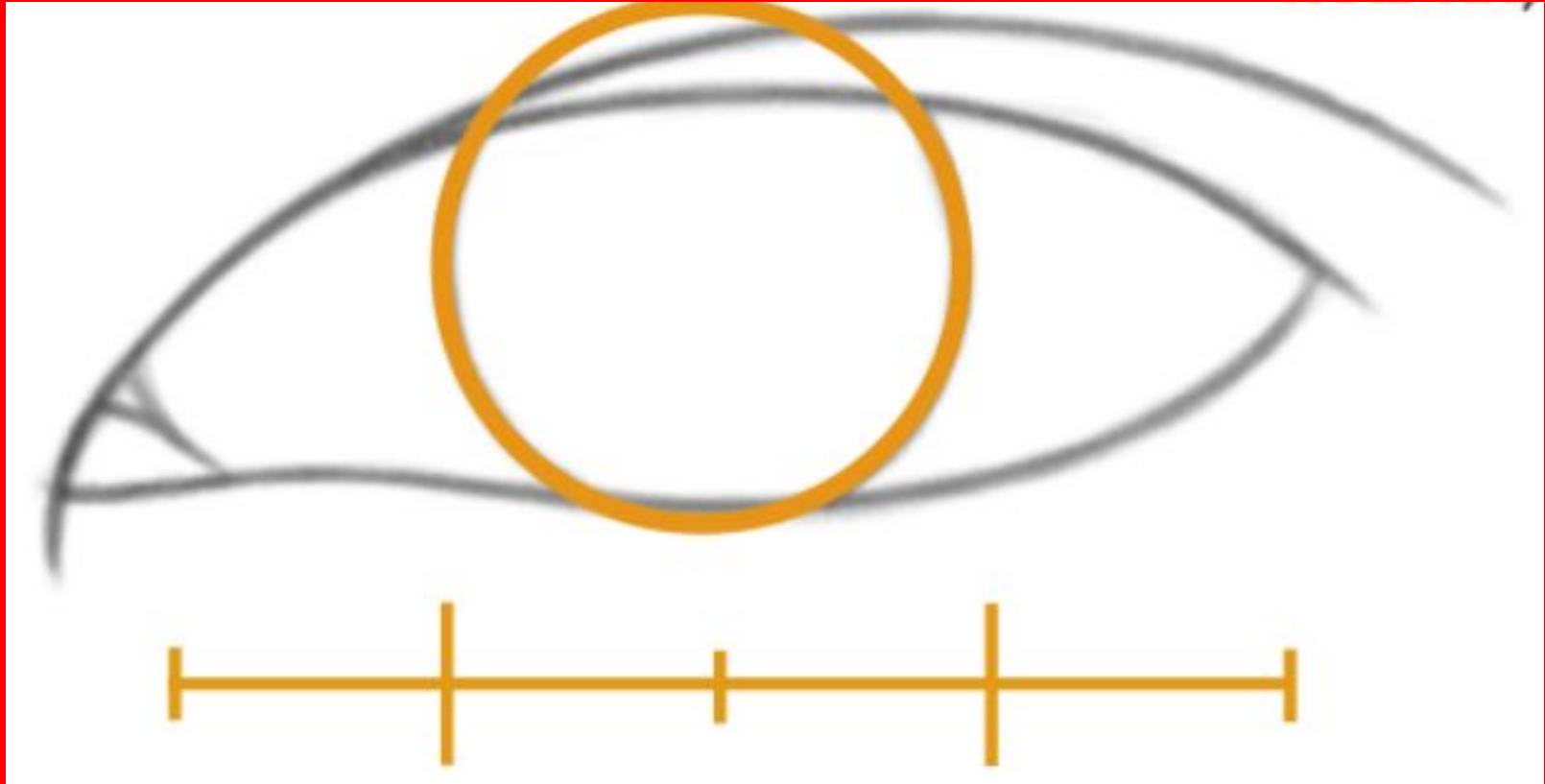
USE YOUR ERASER TO REMOVE THE OUTER  
CIRCLE



Add details in the corners.



The iris is always bigger than we think!





Now you can add details, like the pupil, the lashes and the brows!

**Always start with a circle and a line!**



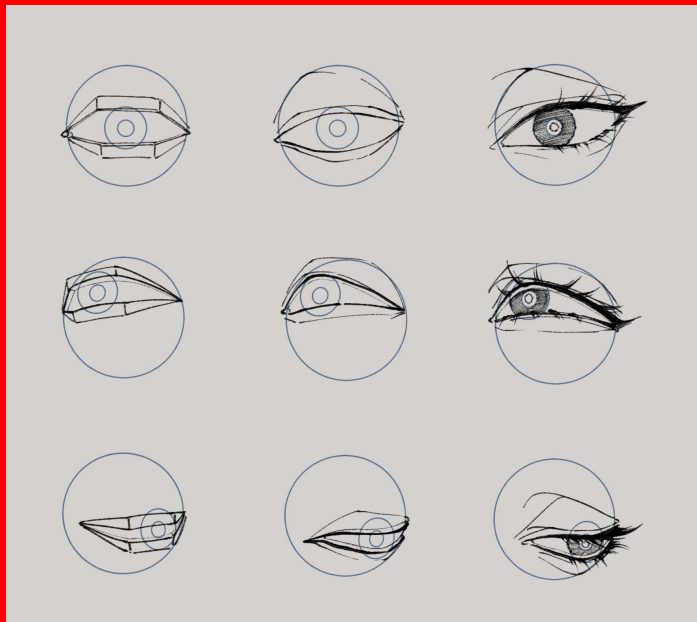
