## ARE YOUR YOUTH BOWLERS \& PARENTS AWARE OF THE RULES???

1. This tournament is certified by the United States Bowling Congress and shall be governed by USBC rules.
2. Competition is open to all 2019-2020 AZ State USBC Youth members. To compete, a bowler must be a regular member of a certified USBC league bowling in an AZ bowling center between Oct $1^{\text {st }}, 2019$ and Feb $28^{\text {th }}, 2020$ and not be under suspension at the time of qualifying.
3. League substitutes can participate if it is their only USBC Youth league. USBC Collegiate members are eligible if they are 2019-2020 Youth members, bowl in an AZ USBC Youth league and have not violated USBC Rule 400.
4. Participants must be aware of each competition level in the state/zone and all associated rules, fees and deadlines. These items are contained in the specific state/zone rules from the State/Zone Pepsi Tournament Director (director information can be found on bowl.com).
5. Competition will be conducted in 12 divisions based on the participant's age. Participation in the wrong age division will lead to automatic disqualification. Bowlers must stay in the given division for their particular league throughout the entire window: All Divisions will be Scratch

6. Entry closing date is February 15,2020 . Tournament form containing qualifiers' name, address, and telephone number, date of birth and Bowler USBC ID number and required fees must be submitted by this date to the tournament director.
7. Athletes are not mandated to be USBC Junior Gold members. However, athletes who earn a spot in the 2019-2020 Junior Gold Championships through this competition must be USBC Junior Gold members or be eligible and buy membership prior to advancement to the USBC Junior Gold Championships.
8. The tournament format shall be: U8 \& U10 Divisions will bowl 3 games on the same pair of lanes. Total pins will determine the winner of $\mathrm{U} 8 \& \mathrm{U} 10$ divisions from each site.

9. No substitutes will be permitted once athletes have started tournament play. However, replacements may be used for bowlers whom are not present 15 minutes prior to the squad time. Competitors shall be allowed 10 minutes of practice time on their starting pair.
10. If no replacement has been made, bowlers arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count beginning with the frame then being bowled. Missed frames shall be credited with a zero. Frames may not be made-up. Bowlers not present when it's their turn to bowl will be credited with a zero for that frame.
11. Only Tournament Bowlers, tournament officials, and center staff shall be permitted in the settee area.
12. Ties will be broken by a one game roll-off. Should a tie still exist, it will be broken by an additional ninth and $10^{\text {th }}$ frame roll-off. (Refer to rule 326a).
13. Claims for errors in scoring or general playing rules must be made to the tournament director no later than the start of the next block or 30 minutes after the completion of competition. Questionable errors shall be decided upon by the tournament director. All other protests must be confirmed in writing to the tournament director within 72 hours of the infraction. Under this rule, each protest must be specific in itself.
14. Symbolic awards will be given on a ratio of 1 in 10 .
15. Scholarships will be awarded to the first place in each of the U12, U15, U17 \& U20 from each sectional site. Additional places will be given awards if entries warrant.
16. Advancement from each of the sectional sites to the state level of competition will be the first 5 places in each of the U12, U15, U17 \& U20 Boys/Girls. In all cases at least one individual per division shall advance. The state level of competition will be held on March 21, 2019 at McRay Lanes, 3825 W. Ray Rd., Chandler, AZ 85226, (480) 899-2171, Check-in at 8:00 AM
17. Appropriate attire worn will be neat, clean and proper fitting. Non-tattered blouses/shirts must have Butterfly Collars or MOCK COLLARS and must have sleeves and be hip length if not tucked in. Nice Pants/Jeans with NO FRAYED HEMLINES or SHORTS may be worn if they go past the fingertips 2 inches while standing with arms relaxed by their side (NO SPORT SHORTS WILL BE ALLOWED), also, no sweatpants, gym pants, nor Leggings will be allowed). Bowlers will not wear hats/caps (unless medically approved). Youth are to be in bowling attire when checking in and must stay in the approved attire until finish bowling. Youth participants will not wear apparel or use bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, an illegal substance, or inappropriate Language/gestures during competition (USBC Rule 301b). Athletes may not smoke or consume alcoholic beverages. The settee and concourse areas will be smoke and alcohol free. This includes E-Cigs. Smoking and alcohol consumption by non-participants will be in designated areas only. No electronic devices will be used by bowlers while bowling in the tournament.
18. All matters not covered by these rules and regulations shall be determined by the State/Zone Pepsi USBC Youth Championships Tournament Committee. The National Pepsi USBC Youth Championships Tournament Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any participant.

ARIZONA STATE LEVEL

RULES \& FORMAT

This tournament is certified by the United States Bowling Congress and shall be governed by USBC rules.

1. Advancement from league is a one-time entry. If an individual who qualified cannot participate in the state/zone competition, replacements will be eligible based on order of finish in previous competition. Replacements must be from the sectional site of the individual unable to compete.
2. Advancement from the sectional sites will be the first 5 places from the Northern site and the first 5 places from the Southern site from each of the U12, U15, U17 and U20 Divisions. In all cases at least one person per division shall advance.
3. Advancers out of the league level must remain in the division they qualified in during all subsequent levels. If a bowler advances out of league level in more than one state/zone, the bowler must declare one state/zone to continue competing before the next competition level. Participation in any level of competition past the league level in more than one state/zone will result in automatic disqualification. The state level of competition will be held on March 21, 2019 at McRay Lanes, 3825 W. Ray Rd., Chandler, AZ 85226, (480) 899-2171, Check-in at 8:00 AM
Entry closing date is March 14, 2020 Tournament entry form containing qualifiers name, address, telephone number and Bowler USBC ID number must be submitted to the tournament director per Sectional Rule 6.
4. Divisions are based on the participant's age. ****Athletes are not mandated to be USBC Junior Gold members to enter. However, athletes who earn a spot in the 2019-2020 Junior Gold Championships through this competition must be USBC Junior Gold members or be eligible and buy membership prior to advancement to the USBC Junior Gold Championships.
5. Competition shall be conducted in the following divisions: Boys/Girls under 12, Boys/Girls under 15, Boys/Girls under 17 and Boys/Girls under 20.
6. Tournament Format: The top 5 bowlers' advancement to the state finals is based on the scores bowled at the sectional sites as stated in rule 2. Each bowler will bowl 6 games across 6 lanes, moving 1 pair to the right after every 2 games. The bowler's 6 game score will determine their final standing. There will be NO Stepladder Finals.
7. Entry fee is $\mathbf{\$ 3 0 . 0 0}$. Payable at tournament site by league check, money order, cashier's check, personal checks or cash will be accepted. If using a check or money order it must be made payable to:.

8. No substitutes will be allowed.
9. Appropriate attire worn will be neat, clean and proper fitting. Non-tattered blouses/shirts must have Butterfly Collars or MOCK COLLARS and must have sleeves and be hip length if not tucked in. Nice Pants/Jeans with NO FRAYED HEMLINES or SHORTS may be worn if they go past the fingertips 2 inches while standing with arms relaxed by their side (NO SPORT SHORTS WILL BE ALLOWED), also, no sweatpants, gym pants, nor Leggings will be allowed). Bowlers will not wear hats/caps (unless medically approved). Youth are to be in bowling attire when checking in and must stay in the approved attire until finish bowling. Youth participants will not wear apparel or use bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, an illegal substance, or inappropriate Language/gestures during competition (USBC Rule 301b). Athletes may not smoke or consume alcoholic beverages. The settee and concourse areas will be smoke and alcohol free. This includes E-Cigs. Smoking and alcohol consumption by non-participants will be in designated areas only. No electronic devices will be used by bowlers while bowling in the tournament.
10. The settee and concourse areas will be smoke and alcohol free. This includes E-Cigs Smoking and alcohol consumption by non-participants will be in designated areas only. No electronic devices will be used by bowlers while bowling in the tournament.
11. No substitutes will be permitted once athletes have started tournament play, however, replacements may be used for bowlers whom are not present 15 minutes prior to the squad time. Replacements in the State Finals must be from the order of finish from the Sectional level of competition.
12. Competitors shall be allowed 10 minutes of practice on their starting lanes prior to the 6 game competitions. Frames missed may not be made-up. A bowler not present when it is their turn to bowl will be credited zero for that frame.
13. If no replacement has been made, bowlers arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count beginning with the frame then being bowled. Missed frames shall be credited with a zero. Frames may not be madeup. A bowler who is not present to bowl when it is their turn will be credited with a zero for that frame.
14. Only bowlers, tournament officials and center staff shall be permitted in the settee area.
15. Ties will be broken by a one game roll-off. Should a tie still exist, it will be broken by an additional 9th and $10^{\text {th }}$ frame roll-off, (Refer to rule 326a).
16. Claims for errors in scoring or general playing rules must be made to the tournament director no later than 30 minutes after the completion of competition. Questionable errors shall be decided upon by the tournament director. All other protests must be confirmed in writing to the tournament director within 72 hours of the infraction. Under this rule, each protest must be specific in itself.
17. Symbolic Awards will be given on a 1 in 10 ratios.
18. Scholarships will be presented to finalist on a 1 in 10 ratios of the Sectional Entries in each of the U12, U15, U17 and U20 divisions. The tournament director is responsible for submitting the scholarships and recipients to the SMART Program, who will administer the scholarships.

19. The first-place winners of the U12, U15, U17 and U20 Girls and Boys Divisions will advance to the 2019-2020 Junior Gold Championships on July 11-18, 2019 in Las Vegas, NV.
20. All advancers to The Junior Gold Championships must have a USBC Junior Gold membership or purchase a USBC Junior Gold membership prior to the championships. These athletes will compete for additional scholarships available to all athletes at the championships, as well as other prizes and awards. The Arizona State USBC will provide a $\mathbf{\$ 3 0 0 . 0 0}$ stipend to the first-place winners of the U12, U15, U17 and U20 Boy/Girl divisions to offset some of their expenses to the Junior Gold Championships. The Stipend will be issued after participating in Las Vegas, Nevada upon the presentation of supporting receipts of actual expenses. All U. S. citizens are vying for a spot on USBC Junior Team 2020 to represent the United States in national and international competition. If the U12, U15, U17 and U20 division champions are unwilling to become a USBC Junior Gold member he/she will not advance to the Championships the athlete will still retain the state/zone scholarships, but the berth and any available stipends to the 2020 Junior Gold Championships will be awarded to the next eligible athlete. Winners are not confirmed as national finalists until they receive a confirmation from USBC.
21. Eligible advancers must agree to bowl in the Junior Gold Championships, or, failing to do so, agree to waive all rights. Replacements will be selected based on the order of finish in their division at the state level. Replacements will incur all costs associated with changing the airline ticket, if applicable.
22. All matters not covered by these rules and regulations shall be determined by the State/Zone Pepsi USBC Youth Championships Tournament Committee. The National Pepsi USBC Youth Championships Tournament Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any participant.
