DESCRIPTION: A while back I bought two bows that were marketed as vintage American models, but neither had a logo or model name on the bow. One of the bows was confirmed as a 1960 Amarco, and the other is this bow. It appears to be a design that is similar to the Cheetah Supreme that is on the cover of the 1964 American Archery company catalog. But I can't guarantee the exact year of model. The specs are stamped into the side of the riser, something American did up until the late 1960's. This bow is still in real good shape for its age. Bow has no delamination. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes. No chips or cracks. One small ding in the middle of the upper back limb. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decal is a reproduction. Overall, this is a nice bow in excellent condition for its age.
