Fisher House Charleston's Good Will Ambassador Spoke and Did a Book Signing for VFW Post 445's Vietnam War 50th Commemorative Year Ceremony!

The James Island, SC Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW) Post 445 held a general membership meeting and 50th Commemorative Year of the War in Vietnam Ceremony, on Saturday, October 12, 2019, at 1:00 pm. Our volunteer Fisher House Charleston Good Will Ambassador, Larry Dandridge was the keynote speaker and did a book signing for the solemn event. Larry provided some memory stirring pictures of Army helicopters in action in Vietnam, a 1968 model Army flight helmet, an old bugle, a display of his books, and a memorable talk. He talked about our great local VA Medical Center, the Miraculous Fisher House Charleston, the Friends of Fisher House Charleston, the Helicopter War in Vietnam, and the *BLADES OF THUNDER (Book One)*, which Larry wrote to help raise \$\$\$\$ for Fisher House.

VFW Post 445 had recently awarded Larry Dandridge with a free membership to VFW Post 445 for his volunteer work with military men and women, veterans, and their families. He works through the Ralph H. Johnson VA, Fisher House Charleston, the Friends of Fisher House Charleston, the Association of the US Army (AUSA), the Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW), the American Legion, the Naval Order of US, the Surface Navy Association, the Daughters of the American Revolution, and many other patriotic organizations to support our veterans. Larry is a Patient Adviser at the VA, a VSO trained volunteer VP for Veteran Affairs with AUSA, a well-known Low Country SC author. He wrote an award winning and all five-star reviewed, military history, non-fiction, and action book about the US Helicopter War in Vietnam in 1968 and 1969. Larry's over 150 meet-the-author events, speeches, and book sales, in the past three years, have raised more than \$68,000.00 for Fisher House Charleston.

VFW 445 is a very active Post that includes veterans and their families supporting our wonderful Fisher House Charleston and Friends of Fisher House Charleston, our terrific Ralph H. Johnson VA Medical Center, and our military men and women, our veterans, and their families. James Island Commissioner and VFW Post 445 member Marilyn Clifford did a wonderful job singing the National Anthem. Marilyn's song, the posting of the POW/MIA Flag and testimony of a Flight Nurse, the Invocation, the

Pledge of Allegiance, the presentation given by US Army LTC (Retired) Larry Dandridge, and the entire ceremony was moving and so appreciated by all who attended. The formal ceremony ended with Larry Dandridge presenting the VFW 445 Post Commander, Jim Barger and Post Chaplain, Chuck Blankin with a Fisher House Charleston Coin, Patch, and Magnet and sincere thank you. After the formal ceremony, a delicious lunch of pulled pork, macaroni and cheese, beans, red rice, and much more was provided by Post 445. A band was also there to provide entertainment.
