BARREL RACING TIP

HAND POSITION... Your hand position, at different levels of training, is something that is very, very important. This is something you will need to learn from an accomplished trainer. The less your horse knows, the further forward your hands should be. The more advanced your horse is, you can bring your hand position back closer to you (but not while training and running the pattern). When a colt is just being broke, I will bring my hand out farther for a lateral move... once they start to understand, I will bring my rein closer to the neck but my hand will be forward above the mid section of their neck. Do not bring your right rein across the neck to the left side and vise-versa. To get the response you need, lift up—not across the neck. There should not be a lot of slack in your reins. There should be about an inch of play unless your horse is more advanced. This way when you need to make contact to ask them for a certain move, you only need to move your hand or fingertips a very short distance. One last thought, it is very important to make sure your hands are not bouncing or balancing on their mouth when there should be slack. Until next month!
