OUTER WEAR

School jackets are encouraged, not required. Jackets must be solid <u>blue or black</u>. Flannel shirts, or jackets with insignias or logos are not allowed. Scarves must be simple Christopher plaid, hunter green, white, black, or navy blue in color. Sweaters or official school sweatshirts may be worn in the classrooms.

FRIDAY MASS AND SCHOOL LITURGIES UNIFORM

- All students are expected to be in their complete school uniform for Friday Mass and School Liturgies.
- Girls are to wear skorts and boys must wear long pants.
- SRM sweaters may be worn in cold weather. Sweatshirts **may not** be worn in the Church.
