Robert V. Beletsky, 75 of Sebowaing, died Monday, Oct. 9 in Scheurer Hospital, Pigeon, following a brief illness.

He was born in Milwaukee, WI, on July 8, 1920. He was married to Mildred Hasselow in Hartland, WI, and she preceded him in death. He then married Ethyle Marquardt on Oct. 10, 1957, in Oconomowoc, WI. She survives him.
