Tara then invited assembly members to share their opinions on two pre-selected topics. Each topic will be noted below, followed by the various comments expressed at the mic. Dan provided additional background on the topics being discussed.

1. Founders' Literature: What general process should we use to classify writings as Recovery, Service, or Archival/Historical? Who should determine the classification?
2. Founders' Literature: What literature do you consider to be in each category of Recovery, Service, or Archival/Historical?

2. Reports from the Officers. There were many reports given. I have put them on the clipboard and can send them to you when they are put on the Area website, if you would like. I have listed motions passed below.

Motions: Area 59 Finance Subcommittee:**2025 Budget Motions**

1. The Finance subcommittee **unanimously recommends that Area 59 contribute \$8,050 to the General Service Office in addition to the Delegate's minimum General Service Conference fee of \$1,800. The fully incurred cost for a Delegate to attend the 2026 GSC is estimated to be \$10,250, with a minimum fee of \$2,200.. Motion passed unanimously.**
2. The Finance subcommittee unanimously recommends that Area 59 adopt its 2026 Budget Proposal. Motion passed unanimously.

Corrections Sub-Committee: Sharon R. attended the 2025 National Prison Conference and brought back the Prison Sponsorship Packet.
