Summer has proven to be quite a challenge. Did anyone ever think Covid-19 would hit us so hard? The Palmetto Club has struggled for 21 weeks thus far. To ensure we provide a safe environment we have added several hand sanitizer dispensers, tables and chairs are being sanitized and disinfected along with restrooms and touch surfaces before every event, the waitstaff is wearing masks and gloves and we are also social distancing. For the next safety step, estimates are being obtained to install UVC lighting to sanitize and disinfect the entire building. We will be the first establishment to have this type of UVC lighting.

At this time we are at 50% capacity which is 138 guests maximum. Hopefully, we will be at full capacity soon. GEI Catering is not booking many events but they are booking. Weddings are the majority of the booking. Some guests previously booked have rescheduled their events others have cancelled. All our civic organizations haven't returned yet. Others are looking at September to return. The UVC lighting will help to get our civic organizations back and to obtain additional bookings.

Lastly, I would like to thank our members for your generous donations to help the club stay afloat. With your continued support, we WILL get thru this. Looking forward to seeing you at our first meeting of the 2020-2021 year on September 4th.


