

## **LOCAL LAW 2 OF THE YEAR 2014 TOWN OF HAMPTON NEW YORK**

A **LOCAL LAW AMENDING LOCAL LAW 1 OF THE YEAR 2014** providing for rescheduling the date for hearing complaints by the Board of Assessment Review,

**BE IT ENACTED**, by the Town Board of Hampton the County of Washington as follows:

### **Section 1: PURPOSE:**

The Town of Hampton, Washington County, New York and the Town of Whitehall, Washington County, New York has pursuant to Section 576 of the Real Property Tax Law appointed the same person to hold the office of sole Assessor. Pursuant to the authority vested in the Town Board by Section 512 of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York, the Town Board wishes to designate a different date for the hearing of complaints by the Board of Assessment Review of the Town of Hampton. The Town Board previously adopted a Local Law 1 of 2014 which had an error and is being remedied by this Local Law.

### **Section 2: DATE FOR HEARING OF GRIEVANCES**

Section 2 of Local Law 1 is hereby amended to hereafter read as follows: Pursuant to Sections 512 of the Real Property Tax Law, the Town of Hampton provides that from and after the effective date of this Local Law, beginning on the Thursday following the fourth Tuesday of May and so many days thereafter as the Board of Assessment Review deems necessary, such board shall meet to hear complaints in relation to assessments.

### **Section 3: SEVERABILITY**

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section, or part of this Local Law or application thereof to any person, individual, corporation, firm, partnership, entity, or circumstances shall be adjudged by the court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not effect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section, or part of this Local Law, or in its application to the person, individual, corporation, firm, partnership, entity, or circumstance directly involved in the controversy in which such order or judgment shall be rendered.

### **Section 4: EFFECTIVE DATE**

This law shall take effect upon its filing with the Secretary of State of the State of New York

**5. (City local law concerning Charter revision proposed by petition.)**


