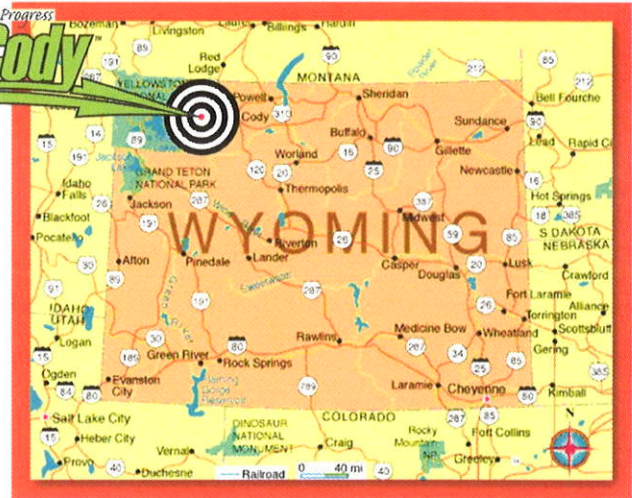

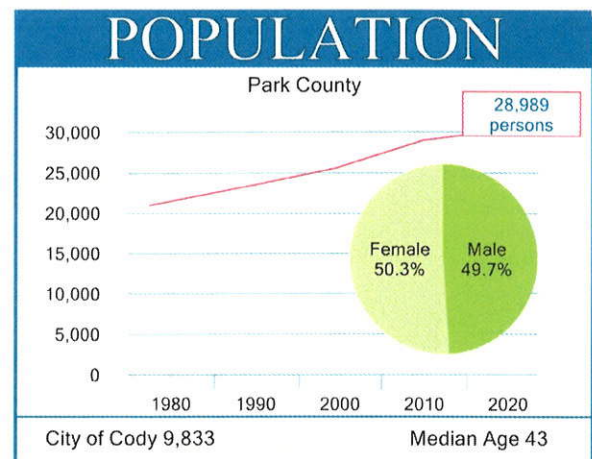
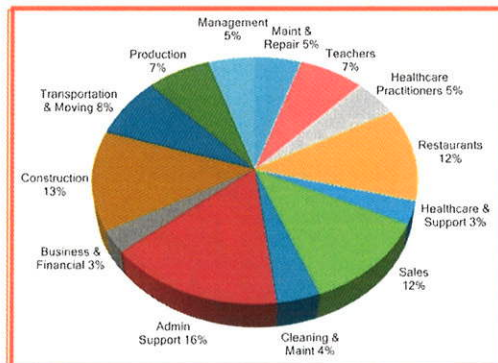

The campus supports a population of approximately 2,200 students at its Powell based campus and its outreach facilities in Cody. Northwest provides 54 associate's degree programs, 19 technical degrees and 34 skill certificates.

27.7% of Park County's population has a Bachelor Degree or higher (second only to Teton County in the state).

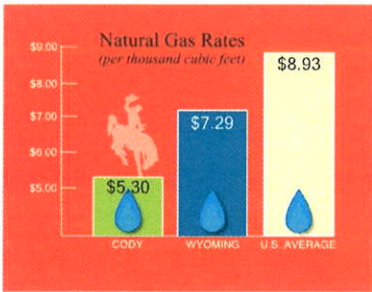
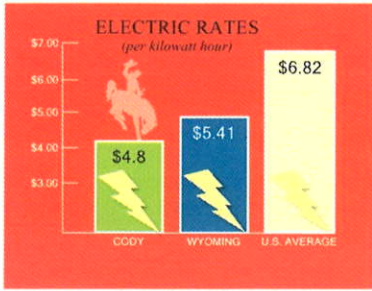
Composition of Labor Force

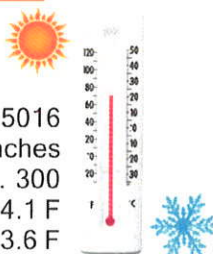
