Lesson Volunteer (Horse Leader or Side Walker)

Lesson volunteers are critical to the success of our riders! They assist the instructor with safety protocols, reinforce instructions as well as support and encouragement. These roles are physical and involve both horses and riders with disabilities. You should be able to follow instructions and communicate clearly any questions or concerns.

Volunteers are expected to show up at least 15 minutes prior to the lesson time to assist with getting the horse ready and greeting the riders.

Horse Leader:

This person is responsible for leading the horse throughout the mounting, lesson and dismounting. The primary focus should always remain on the horse. Training by Giddy-Up is mandatory prior to volunteering in classes.

Sidewalker:

Sometimes working alone, sometimes with a fellow sidewalker, depending on the rider's needs, this person remains focused on the rider. They are expected to reinforce the instructor's requests and encourage the rider in a positive way.

Volunteer Sub (Called when needed)

Subs are needed when a regular volunteer isn't available or if someone calls out at the last minute. When a situation arises where a Sub is needed, the instructor or volunteer coordinator will reach out to all subs asking for anyone who is able to fill in.

Barn Helper (Mucking Stalls)

The Giddy Up horses prefer clean stalls and we can use all the help we can get in maintaining them! If you are up for some shoveling we would love your help. Training will be provided. This is physical role that involves walking, shoveling and pushing a (full) wheelbarrow. Good boots are recommended!

Horse Helper (Exercise Horses)

Even though our horses work hard during lessons they need regular exercise and additional schooling to reinforce good behaviors. If you have experience riding horses we'd love to do an evaluation to see if you could be a horse helper!
