MASS THEME

Theme: Christian Joy Tempered by Trials
Human beings cannot live without joy. If life consisted only of funerals without weddings, only of work without recreation (a party, a show, a vacation), the burden of human existence would be unbearable for most of us. However, expecting too much joy from life is also dangerous because it easily results in disappointment. Friends may tell us enthusiastically about a new movie in town: "You must see it!" We look forward with great anticipation to it and finally get to see it. In most cases, we come away sorely disappointed by it! Similarly, at every wedding, the mother of the bride sheds a tear of joy but it becomes a tear of sadness when the bride leaves home to follow her husband. During the fifty days of Easter, the Liturgy of the Church invites us to be joyful because Christ, our Savior, is risen and we as God's adopted children will live with him forever. Christians have reasons for joy, but we should not forget that God's kingdom has only been initiated in us. The full realization will come later. On this side of the grave we will have to live with the tension between "already" and "not yet." Expecting too much from Church and religion may disillusion you, and it takes maturity and courage to cope with this situation. Today's Bible readings deal with Christian existence that is often joy mingled with tears.

BIBLICAL COMMENTARY

FIRST READING Acts 14:21-27
[Conversion of the Gentiles]
On their way home from their missionary journey, Paul and Barnabas revisit the congregations that they have previously founded. Notice the encouragement "to persevere in the faith...: 'It is necessary for us to undergo many hardships if we are to enter into the kingdom of God.'" Indeed the Christian can sing: "[God] Your kingdom is a kingdom for all ages, and your dominion endures through all generations. I will praise your name forever" (Responsorial Psalm). We have reason for abundant joy, but we must be ready to undergo trials as a condition to enter God's kingdom.
SECOND READING Rv 21:1-5a
[God's Dwelling]
Utilizing the language of vision, the sacred writer consoles those who must "undergo many hardships" (First Reading). According to the ancients, storms at sea were thought to be caused by evil monsters; hence, "sea" stood for threat and peril. Accordingly, the words "the sea was no more" mean that all peril had passed. The author also sees "the holy city, a new Jerusalem": God had been present in the sanctuary of the old Jerusalem temple; now there will be a new kind of divine presence, enjoyed by all the members of God's people. All these new things are initiated in their lives as Christians, but they will be fully realized only later. During Easter Time, meditation on God's saving presence may help us to persevere in the faith.
