Donald R. Hoagg, 68 of Sebewaing, died unexpectedly Wednesday afternoon, Oct. 21, at Bay Medical Center, Bay City.

He was born Nov. 27, 1923, in Detroit, the son of Walter and Archina (Campbell) Hoagg. He served in the US Army during World War II. Mr. Hoagg was married to Virginia Mae Loeffler on June 9, 1951, in Sebewaing, and she survives.

He had managed the former Lincoln Theater in Sebewaing for several years, and was employed at Michigan Printing Company in Bad Axe for 30 years before retiring in 1983. He was a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church of Sebewaing.

Surviving, besides his wife, Virginia of Sebewaing, are one son and daughter-in-law, Gary and Cindy Hoagg of Sebewaing, three daughters and sons-in-law, Janice and Tom Sting and Karen Hoagg of Sebewaing, and Nancy and Charles Dorsch of Gagetown, also eight grandchildren, one sister, Dorothy Hoagg of Royal Oak and one nephew.

One brother, James Hoagg, preceded him in death. His mother, Archina Hoagg, died Sept. 27, 1992.

Funeral services were held Saturday afternoon, Oct. 24, in Immanuel Lutheran Church with Rev. Martin J. Hagenow officiating. Burial was in the church cemetery. Dinkel-Juengel Funeral Home was in charge of arrangements.
