Have you ever heard something and thought, 'that can't be right' only to realize it is absolutely true. I had a conversation with someone about carpet cleaning and I was explaining what Sears Carpet Cleaning out of Pittsburgh used to clean apartment buildings. I felt like I knew a little bit about this because once upon a time I worked cleaning carpets for Sears Carpet Cleaning. Later that night I was telling my wife about the conversation and when I mentioned again how I had worked at Sears Carpet Cleaning she responded, "that was like 20 years ago!". I thought, 'no it wasn't that long ago, I was in college....oh....right....that was twenty three years ago'. Sometimes we hear something and at first it doesn't compute, but when we allow it to sink in we realize it's validity.

I heard a minister on K-love just this past week say something to the effect of: "Satan knows Jesus better than we do". At hearing that I thought, 'no, that can't be right, no, just no'. But then as I thought about it I was like 'oh yeah', 'I guess so'. If we think about it Satan does know God better than we do. Satan knows the scriptures, knows all of them, every word. Satan has spoken with God (Job 1-2), has talked with Jesus in person (Matthew 4), and has witnessed everything from creation to resurrection. Satan knows Jesus, knows faith, knows that God is indeed real. Satan doesn't question the existence of God. But yet there is still an obvious problem with Satan and it is this: Satan does not love God! It seems knowing about God, knowing about Jesus isn't enough. There has to be love!

Deuteronomy 6:5 says, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might." Jesus expands upon this commandment in Matthew 22 which reads: "[Jesus] said to him, " 'You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' This is the greatest and first commandment." Taken together, we are directed to love our God with all that we are; mind, body, and spirit!

We love God with our mind: God wants us to use our brains. We are to think and explore and learn about all of the things on the earth, but even more so, learn about God. We do this by actually reading the scriptures, by studying them, discussing them, praying on them. We must use our minds to gain wisdom and understanding so that we can live how God intends for us to live.

We love God with our bodies: You've no doubt heard it said that your body is a temple. And while it is true we should care for our bodies through healthy living, exercise, and diet; I believe this part of the command is also an invitation to use our bodies to show love. One of my favorite expressions of love is when my daughter runs across the room and dives into my arms for a big bear hug! How we use our bodies to love God includes our kindness to one another. It is about the aid we give with our hands, feet, and mouth. We say that the body of Christ consists of the women and men God has claimed; we show bodily love to God by using our bodies to love one another.

We love God with our spirit: This is where faith in Christ, the acceptance of our guilt and shame and our reliance on the good news of the resurrection comes into play. But as see with Satan it isn't enough to just know this. We have to feel it, internalize it, accept the reality of our sin and experience the laying it aside to follow Jesus. This is when our soul longs for and needs Christ, more and more daily.

Friends knowing Jesus existed is not the same as loving Jesus with your mind. Doing good deeds to others is not the same as doing them as though you were serving Christ your Lord. Feeling good is not the same as feeling grace. I pray that love grows in you; and that you do indeed love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your might!

For generations, church camp has been a place where kids make life changing decisions to be in a relationship with Jesus.

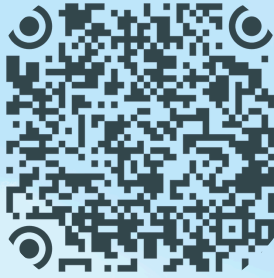

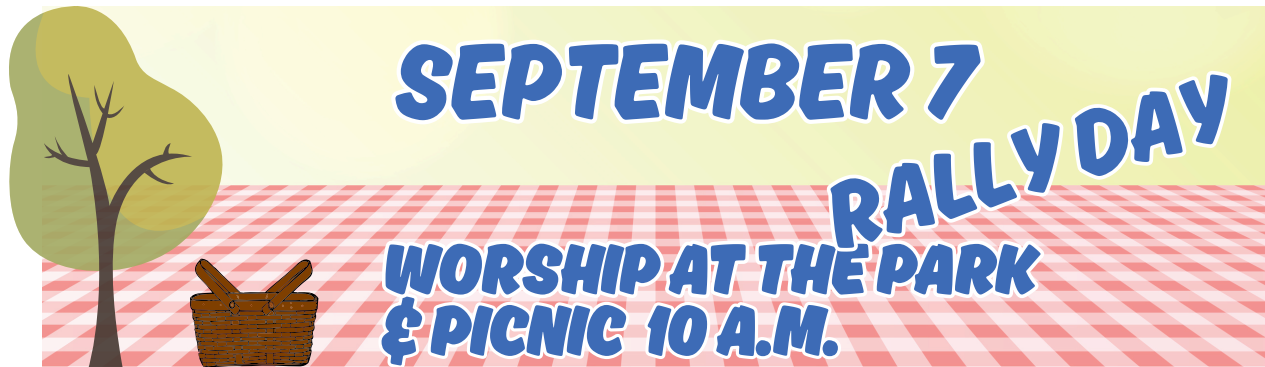

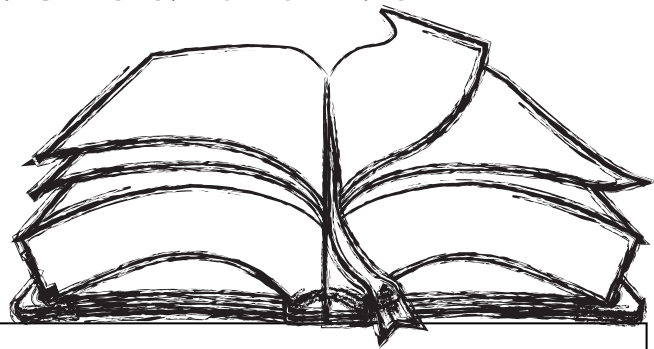
