One day, he made the comment to me, "No wonder you guys have the tamest herd of cows on my route, they are listening to religious music or preaching every time I come into this barn!" Kudos to you, WRVM. You even have a calming effect on the cows! Even greater than that, my then 17-year-old-son gave his life to Christ one evening milking cows while listening to John MacArthur on your radio station. He is now a Baptist minister in Texas. For many, many years, I struggled with my own faith, I never felt forgiven for all the mistakes I made throughout my life. I put up a barrier between me and God. Then one day, I turned on WRVM. I have no idea who said it, but this was the message: "If you don't feel forgiven, it isn't because God hasn't forgiven you. It's because you won't forgive yourself." I had to learn to trust in God's total forgiveness. The shame and the guilt I carried around for so many years was finally lifted off my shoulders. Now, I'm the old lady that has her house and car radios set to tune into WRVM every time I turn the radio on. My faith gets a little stronger every time I press that power button!
