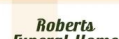

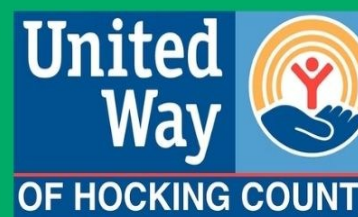

KIT



Kit essentials

- **Water and food:**
 - A supply of at least one gallon of water per person per day, plus non-perishable food.
- **Light and communication:**
 - A flashlight, extra batteries, and a battery-powered or hand-crank radio. A whistle can be used to signal for help.
- **First aid and medicine:**
 - A well-stocked first-aid kit and any prescription medications you or your family members need.
- **Tools:**
 - A manual can opener, multi-purpose tool, and potentially a wrench or pliers to turn off utilities.
- **Documents:**
 - Copies of important documents like identification, insurance policies, and birth certificates.
- **Hygiene:**
 - Moist towelettes, garbage bags, and other personal hygiene items.
- **Clothing and bedding:**
 - A change of clothes, sturdy shoes, and a warm blanket or sleeping bag for each person.
- **Cash and chargers:**
 - Some cash in small bills and a portable phone charger or power bank.
- **Special needs:**
 - Any items for family members with special needs, such as glasses, hearing aids, or pet supplies.
- **Shelter:**
 - If the emergency is a disaster where you may be sheltering in place, include plastic sheeting and duct tape.
