We will spend time in the Dead Sea area visiting Masada and Qumran. Jerusalem brings excitement as we will see the Western Wall, visit the Mt. of Olives, and walk the Way of the Cross.

This tour includes airfare, hotels with breakfast and dinners, comfortable A/C coach, transfers, entrance fees, a scholarly guide, and many extras at one price that individual travel cannot match. Join Pastor Chris on this exciting and spiritual pilgrimage to Israel.

Israel Itinerary

Day 1 Depart U.S. for flight to Israel.

Day 2 Arrive Tel Aviv Ben Gurion Airport. Meet our guide and transfer to hotel. Overnight in Jerusalem area.

Day 3 Later start from hotel. Begin the day by visiting the Israeli Museum. After lunch, visit Mt. Zion with the Upper Room, the site of the last supper, David's Tomb, and St. Peter's in Gallicantu, which is built over the site of the house of the High Priest Caiaphas and the stone pit where Jesus was held. Three times, Peter also denied knowing Jesus near this same place. Overnight in Jerusalem area.

Day 4 We will visit the Mt. of Olives; Church of the Ascension, then begin the "Palm Sunday" walk, stopping at Pater Noster Church, commemorating Jesus' teaching His disciples the Lord's Prayer and end in the Garden of Gethsemane, the place of Jesus' agony, betrayal and arrest, and Church of All Nations, which contains the rock where Jesus is believed to have prayed before His betrayal and arrest. After lunch, begin the Way of the Cross/Via Dolorosa, the Way of Sorrows, which tradition says Jesus went with the cross to Calvary. Today, it passes through the colorful Old City markets to the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. Overnight in Jerusalem area.

Day 5 Early start from hotel. Today you will visit the Temple Mount and Western Wall. Continue to Bethlehem, Church of the Nativity and Shepherd's Field, and lunch at the Grotto. Overnight in Jerusalem area.

Day 6 Early start from hotel. Drive south along the Dead Sea to visit Masada, the fortress of Herod. Continue to ancient ruins of Qumran, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. After lunch, enjoy floating in the Dead Sea. Time permitting, view the Mt. of Temptation in Jericho. Overnight in Jerusalem area.

Day 7 Check out of the hotel. Visit the Garden Tomb. Drive north through the Jordan Valley to Beit She'an, the ancient biblical city, which the Greeks and Romans knew as Scythopolis. Prior to checking in to the hotel, visit Mt. Precipice. Overnight in Galilee area.

Day 8 Morning visit to Caesarea Philippi and Tel Dan. After lunch, visit Yardenit; Jordan River. Overnight in Galilee area.

Day 9 Sea of Galilee, including: the Mount of Beatitudes; Tabgha, the place of Jesus' miracle of the Multiplication of the Fish and Loaves, Primacy of Peter, and Capernaum: known as "Jesus' hometown." After lunch, visit Magdala and take a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. Overnight in Galilee area.

Day 10 Check out of the hotel. Drive to Tzippori-Sepphoris and visit the ancient city. Continue to Caesarea Maritime and the aqueduct. Check in to the hotel. Tonight, you will have a farewell dinner. Overnight in Tel Aviv.

Day 11 Transfer to airport for flight to the U.S. Arrive back to the U.S.
