SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES
TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 26, 2019, 6:30 P.M.

Attendance: Selectmen: Jeffrey Sanborn, Dwight Warren and Jim Dolloff as well as members of the Public.

1. **Selectmen Meeting was called to order approximately at 6:30 PM by Jeffrey Sanborn.**

2. **Review/ Approve meeting minutes**

Jeff Sanborn requested making a motion to accept and approve February 12, 2019 meeting minutes. Jim Dolloff made a motion, Dwight Warren seconded the motion; Selectmen voted 3-0 to approve meeting minutes.

3. **Review/ Approve warrant**

Jeff Sanborn requested making a motion to accept and approve February 26, 2019 warrant. Jim Dolloff made a motion, Dwight Warren seconded the motion; Selectmen voted 3-0 to approve the warrant.

4. **New Business**

- Selectmen reviewed and voted 3-0 to sign the farmland and open space applications prepared by Cumberland County Assessing.
- Selectmen reviewed and voted 3-0 to sign the Cumberland County
- The Selectmen office got a price for adding a sign out front where the Town posts events/ meetings. Sebago Signworks provided a quote between \$425 - \$750 to add a sign on top of the already existing sign. The price to install it would be \$95 per hour, for two people. The Selectmen tabled the discussion until the workshop.
- Michelle Collomy would like to do an essential oil workshop after town meeting on March 9th at 6:30PM. Selectmen approved it, town meeting should be over by then.
- Shovel and Spoon contacted the town office and has an interest in renting the commercial kitchen. They will be providing more information on their needs and an offer. Wes Sunderland asked if they would need a conditional use permit. Selectmen discussed and that type of use was included in the CUP for the building, so it shouldn't be needed.

Old Business

- Selectmen voted 3-0, discussed and signed the Selectmen Guidelines and Procedure Policy for the Town.
- The Baldwin Historical Society has some murals that were made by children when they attended the Baldwin Consolidated Elementary School. Selectmen discussed and voted 3-0 to allow them to be hung in the town office.
- The Senior Luncheon went very well. It was well attended. Connie made corn chowder and beef stew that was delicious! There were also a variety of desserts and a lecture by Sacopee Valley Adult Education.


