

ELMER BUEHLER

1920 - 1990

Elmer E. Buehler, age 69 of Bad Axe, passed away Wednesday, March 7 at his home.

He was born April 27, 1920 in Sebawaing, son of the late Julius and Martha (Koch) Buehler. He was united in marriage on Nov. 18, 1945 to Jean L. Snider in Sebawaing.

Mr. Buehler owned and operated Elmer's Barber Shop in Bad Axe from 1945-85. He was an active member of Our Savior Lutheran Church, Bad Axe, and the Bad Axe Lions Club. He also was a member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars Pigeon Post and served in the U. S. Army during World War II.

Mr. Buehler was a past officer of the Senior Citizens Meal Site and served on the board for the Commission on Aging. He also was active in the area's Care and Share Program.

He is survived by his wife Jean, Bad Axe; one son, Dr. Douglas Buehler, Pigeon; one daughter, Boni Carpenter, Bad Axe; six grandchildren; one sister, Leona Behnke, Essexville; one stepbrother, Clarence Schweitzer, Greenville; two step-sisters, Eleanor Rivet, Bay City and Lorna Bartels, Saginaw.

Mr. Buehler was preceded in death by two brothers, Harold and Louis Buehler.

Funeral services were held 11 a.m. Saturday at Our Savior Lutheran Church. The Rev. Roger Heintz officiated with burial in the Colfax Cemetery.
