SECTION 1: The Corporate Authorities find that the need for confidentiality still exists in order to protect the public interest and/or privacy of an individual and all such closed session minutes during February 2015 thru July 2015 shall remain closed at this time.

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
