In this most recent supplement, the report has been co-branded and presented with Douglas Elliman, New York's largest residential brokerage, to deliver a widely reaching yet exacting picture of global economy.

The information contained within the report is a curated collection of economic perspective reflecting the attitude of more than 23,000 high networth individuals, including contributions from such leading commentators as Sir Richard Branson, former US economic advisor Dr. Pippa Malmgren and leading Malaysian industrialist Tan Sri A K Nathan.

Among the key findings in the Wealth Report are those of particular interest to the Private Air New York readership; namely, information placing New York alongside London as the key global city economies over the next decade. Having been named to the list in prior years, the newest findings see New York firmly set in that coveted position as it continues to attract growing investment in the prime housing market. Since second quarter 2009, the prime New York market has experienced an impressive 36% cumulative price growth, earning it the top spot on the list of US markets and putting it second only to London on the global level.
