<u>Service Opportunities / Trash Pick-up Volunteers Needed</u> _TBLA will host a volunteer TRASH PICKUP on Friday June 3, at 7 am. Volunteers should meet in the SCOA parking lot at 7:00am for a safety briefing and to be assigned in teams of two or three people to sections of HWY 191, between Toledo Town and the Lanana Bridge. We are starting early to beat the heat. Picker tools, trash bags, and safety vests will be available. Service Opportunities / Fingerling Release Volunteers Needed — We will be conducting a Florida Bass Fingerling Release on Tuesday, June 7 at 7:30 am at the Cypress Bend Marina. 50,000 fingerlings purchased by TBLA will be distributed to TBLA Members who will release the fingerlings into Toledo Bend. Handling and release instructions will be provided to the members that receive the fingerlings. You must be an active, 2022 member of TBLA to participate in the release. You can join TBLA or update your dues for 2022 at the Fingerling Release. A Membership form can be found at the end of this newsletter. Please have this form completed ahead of time and bring a check or correct change to pay your dues to speed up the distribution process for those that are not a member or have not paid your 2022 dues. We will have an updated membership list at the site to confirm memberships if you are not sure of your membership status.

TBLA volunteers will direct traffic in a single line to the distribution point in the Cypress Bend Marina Parking Lot, and you will be able to drive up adjacent to the fingerling distribution site where volunteers will place the bags of fingerlings in your vehicle. Fingerlings will be distributed in oxygen filled air bags. We ask that you bring clean, empty, medium to large ice chests, 5-gallon buckets or containers to hold and protect the bagged fingerlings while they are being transported to your release site. You can pick up the fish up by boat or by vehicle at the Cypress Bend Marina Launch area. We normally complete the distribution of the fingerlings in less than 2 hours. We will distribute **two** bags of fingerlings per member present in the transport vehicle or boat, with no more than **six** bags placed in a single vehicle or boat.
