

### **Important Reminders**

#### **Payment Collection and the Registration Process**

All completed registrations should be done online at the BGCVA's secure website, <a href="https://www.bgcva.org/events">www.bgcva.org/events</a>, or sent to the Baptist General Convention of Virginia State Office via US mail service or personally delivered. Please make sure that you have included in your registration any late fees that your church might have incurred if you registered after the deadline. \*\*You will receive a confirmation upon receipt of full payment. All payments MUST be received before the date of the retreat. There is no onsite registration.\*\*

#### Cancellation/Refund Policy

Cancellations prior to the early registration deadline will receive a full refund. Groups who cancel after the early registration deadline will receive 50% of their money back unless the cancellation happens with seven business days of the actual retreat, whereby the group forfeits all monies paid. \*\*There are No credits and No rain checks for late registrations.\*\*

#### **Substitution Policy**

Substitutions (changing one attendee for another) prior to the registration deadline can be made. Substitutions past the registration deadline MUST be within the same gender and grade range (i.e.: male youth for male youth/female adult for female adult). Please inform the BGCVA State Office at least one (1) week prior to the retreat date of any substitutions. No substitutions after one week prior. \*Churches are strongly encouraged to have 1 male & female adult leader alternate in case a primary adult group leader is unable to attend.\*

#### Provide Leadership

This event is designed to help you as well as your youth deepen your relationship with God. Adult volunteers will be responsible for making sure your youth are following guidelines that have been outlined. The BGCVA Retreat Staff is not responsible for monitoring and disciplining your youth. Any major discipline infraction reported to the BGCVA Retreat Staff will result in the church group being sent home without refund, immediately.

#### Transportation

Groups must provide their own transportation to the retreat site. At the retreat site there is an area for Charter buses to pick up and departure. The Convention does not offer transportation.

### **Frequently Asked Questions**

How many Youth Retreats does the Convention host a year and where: BGCVA this year will sponsor one (1) retreat, for Middle and High School students, 6<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup> Grades Only. The retreat is held at the VUU (Virginia Union University), 1500 North Lombardy Street, Richmond, Virginia 23220.

**How long is the retreat:** The retreat is a three day—two night event. Beginning on a Thursday afternoon and concluding Saturday morning.

**Does my church need to send adults leaders:** Yes! A church may bring as many adult leaders as they wish. However, we require that churches have a ratio of 1 male leader for every 4-5 male youth and 1 female leader for every 4-5 female youth.

**Is there a registration cost:** Yes, the early registration cost is \$145.00 per person; this cost includes lodging, five (5) meals, all activities, and retreat materials for the retreat. There is a late registration cost of \$160.00 per person. \*There are only 500 youth and 100 adult spots available.\*

When is check-in: Check-in begins at 3:00 pm on Thursday (and will continue until all churches have arrived). Check-in will be at the Living & Learning Center on VUU's campus (#31 on campus map; see back cover of this registration packet). There is a mandatory adult leaders orientation at 6:30 pm. Only one adult leader per church is required to come.

What about the accommodations: The retreat provides lodging for 600 persons. All rooms have electricity, full bathrooms, bunk beds, chairs. Each church will be assigned single-sex lodging accommodations for the retreat. The size of each church will determine their lodging assignment. Some churches may be assigned a room with another church. There is NO CO-ED visitation permitted during the retreat.

What should I wear during the retreat: Dress is casual (no revealing clothing) for the retreat. Bring comfortable clothing and shoes. The weather is usually warmer during the day, but may be cooler at night.

**Do adult leaders have to fill out the medical waiver also:** Yes, all persons (youth & adults) in order to attend the retreat must completely fill out the medical waiver. The medical waiver should be turned in along with the retreat registration.

What do churches do about youth taking medication: Adult leaders should be aware of any medical condition that may affect their students. Youth should carry and administer their medication at all times. In case of emergency a medical professional will be contacted.

**BGC's Got Talent** is a ministry showcase/talent show where church ministry groups (mime/step/dance/song/poetry/prose) are given an opportunity to display their gifts/talents in front of the entire retreat family. 7




