1900 - 1987

Margaret E. Duby, age 86 of Brookfield Township, died Sunday morning, April 19 at Saginaw St. Mary's Hospital, following a brief illness.

She was born Oct. 20, 1900 in Saginaw County, daughter of the late Fred A. and Amelia (Kurtzhals) Wenzel. On Dec. 23, 1916 she was united in marriage to Lloyd Duby, Sr., in Saginaw County and they resided in that area for many years. He preceded her in death in 1972. After her retirement in 1970, Mrs. Duby moved to the Sebewaing area.

Mrs. Duby was a member of St. John's Lutheran Church, Kilmanagh, the Ladies' Aid, Widows' Club, Gold Star Mothers, Women's Benefit Association and the Unionville-Sebewaing Area Senior Citizens.

Surviving are four sons, Robert of Harrison, Francis of Montrose, Lloyd, Jr. of Saginaw and Lyle of Beaverton; two daughters, Mrs. Oscar (Esther) Haag of Sebewaing and Mrs. James (Charlotte) Dargie of Bridgeport; 21 grandchildren; 37 great-grandchildren and three great-great-grandchildren; four sisters, Lula Ehinger of West Branch, Sophia Buffington of Saginaw, Annie Huffman of Springport and Rose Kruger of Hemlock; and four brothers, Edward Wenzel of Saginaw, Louis and Ray Wenzel, both of Hemlock and Thomas Wenzel of Merrill.

Preceding her in death were three daughters, Mary, Sally and Marion Duby, and one son, Kenneth, all of whom died in infancy; two sons, Woodrow and Bernard Duby who both died in World War II, three sisters and two brothers.

Funeral services will be conducted at 11 a.m. Wednesday, April 22 from St. John's Lutheran Church, Kilmanagh. Rev. Robert Pfaff will officiate with burial in the Owen Cemetery, near Saginaw.
