We went mobile, as you know, September 3rd.
If we add the number of people
who have attended breakfast, in nine weeks
as of this writing — we have served 257 meals!

This ministry is not a “one man band.”

First, we have had many (countless) prayers
going up on our behalf. People connected
to HCC and concerned Christians
in many other places
who know of this ministry
and want it to do well are praying.

Second, we have been blessed financially.

It was stated from the beginning,
this is a faith-based ministry.

Our general fund is not where CTT
receives its support. To those at HCC
who have provided funds and to those outside
HCC, a debt of gratitude belongs to you.

Third, we have some incredible volunteers!
This ministry would die without them! We have
people at the building every Saturday morning
making the breakfast to be transported
to our serving site, thus requiring
someone to bring it!

Then at our site we have another group
of fantastic volunteers. The trailer
has to be taken to our site. Canopies, tables,
chairs and the food serving line
have to be set up! Our guests are served
by volunteers. Then everything is taken down,
brought back to the building and dishes
requiring washing are done
with all to be repeated the following Saturday!!

A call for help went out, Thursday,
October 27th, to help make some gift bags
to give away at breakfast on October 29th.
It was encouraging to have people arrive
that don't participate on Saturdays.

This demonstrates concern for the ministry
and gave others an opportunity
to be a part of the work.

To those of you who helped out—**Thank you!**

Where would this ministry be
without dedicated people
providing our needs? This is not
an exhaustive list but here is how God
has provided. Everything listed was donated
or is being donated:

Blackstone Griddle, food warmers,
pancake mix, propane, sausage/bacon, eggs,
coffee, collapsible trash can,
hygiene products, milk, tea, lemonade, ice,
orange juice, syrup, sugar, napkins,
paper towels, plastic ware, and cups.
This gives an idea of what it takes
for this ministry to operate.

Funds given have provided: Canopies, tables,
banner, logo placed on our trailer, portable
JBL battery powered PA system, coolers,
chairs, cd player, speaker stand.
Again, this is not an exhaustive list.

When God's people **work together**
it is amazing what can be accomplished.

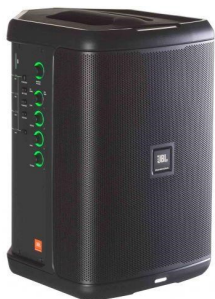
If you know someone that is looking

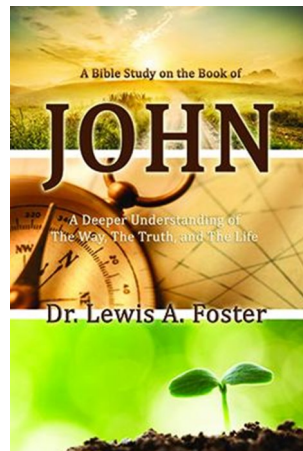

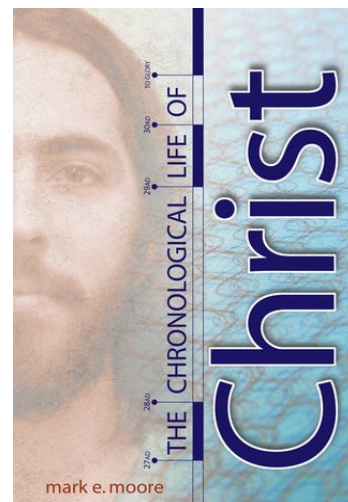
