

SPECIAL MEETING REPORT WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 13th

The following club members met to discuss the scheduled clean out of the clubs storage shed. Attending were: Deb & Bill Werner, Wayne Henson, Dave Lantz, Craig Sheridan, Steve Kindell via phone, Wayne & Phyllis Orrison. Our goal was/is to identify the items we have in storage that we regularly use and those items we no longer use and/or haven't used in years and what to do with it. We had a lot of good discussion.

We started with trying to ID the things that we do use. The following list is not necessarily in any sort of order/priority, nor is it complete, but identified here to **spark your memories** of

things we have used and perhaps things that we overlooked during our brainstorming at the meeting. We also would like your inputs at the March Meeting before we act. The following are items we felt we should keep are and still have a use for: all the Little Hershey "stuff" (signs field lay out equipment, etc.), tables and chairs, at least a couple of coffee pots, Santa Suit, coolers, grill, styrofoam cups, plastic cups (50th anniversary cups) and the galvanized cooler.

Some items need to be further evaluated: the Christmas Model T "sled" and Reindeer and all the lighting, all the plastic kitchen storage tubs, the signage from the Mid West Chapter and other kitchen items like the floor pads used in our Little Hershey kitchen.

Many items were thought to be items that could be distributed among club members via some kind of auction or biding process - TBD.

Games might be giving to a church or other organization for some kind of game night/kids play type activity.

There are some albums with pictures that most current club members are not familiar with. One suggestion was to put these on our web site, but we will need some help sorting and prioritizing and identifying of picture content. This would be a task for a small committee and it really should be done. Steve Kindell is willing to help.

There was no decision regarding the disposition of all this "stuff," but rather a consensus that we need to trim down the shed stuff and find a best use for what we don't need. At the **next meeting**, **March 4th**, ideas for how to best proceed will be discussed. Because we felt that an itemized list of "stuff" should be provided and the timing of the scheduled shed clean out is so near the end April, we should consider moving that clean out date up so that we can have the shed cleaned out, items listed and then be ready to move on to Little Hershey Activity. This is to be discussed and voted on at the meeting.

One possible method of getting rid of the items deemed excess is to sell it at Little Hershey. Duane Bunton volunteered to place those items in his swap meet space. Again, at this time, there is no final decision about the disposition of the shed items.

Also, Dave Lantz gave and update concerning Little Hershey. Dave said he signed the 3-D Sound contract and is distributing Little Hershey fliers at events where they are DJ'ing. Also, discussion took place about advertising and ideas for free ads. Steve Kindell said Hemming's and the Model T Times, the Morning Blend on TV and the Model A Times are also advertising Little Hershey for free.

April 4th is Cars & Coffee event across from Katie's Cup, 7th St., Rockford and discussion took place to advertise (maybe with sandwich boards?) Little Hershey.

Please come to the March meeting and help us move forward on this job.
