ORDINANCE NO. 4

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR TWO YEAR STAGGERED TERMS FOR THE OFFICE OF MAYOR AND COUNCILMEN, AND PROVIDING THAT AT THE FIRST MEETING OF THE COUNCIL FOLLOWING THE NEXT ANNUAL ELECTION, THE MAYOR AND THE COUNCILMEN SHALL DETERMINE BY LOT WHO OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCILMEN SHALL SERVE TWO YEAR TERMS AND WHO SHALL SERVE ONE YEAR TERMS IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 1143 OF VERNON'S ANNOTATED CIVIL STATUTES OF THE STATE OF TEXAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOG CABIN, TEXAS:

SECTION I.

That in accordance with Article 1143 of Vernon's Annotated Civil Statutes of Texas, that the terms of office of the mayor and the councilmen shall hereafter be staggered. Immediately following the next annual election after adoption of this Ordinance, it shall be determined by lot which of the six office holders, the mayor and five councilmen, shall have a two year term and which shall have a one year term so that one-half of said officers shall have two year terms and one-half of said officers shall have a one year term. Thereafter and beginning at the next succeeding annual election all of said officers shall have two year terms.

SECTION II.

The fact that the City of Log Cabin now has no ordinance governing the matter regulated herein and that it is deemed to be in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Log Cabin that their officers serve staggered terms, creates an emergency, which is here and now declared, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in force, from and after its passage and publication, as provided by law.
