

Course Description:

This updated for 2017, **Non-Language Specific three (3) credit hour CIMCE course** will familiarize the student with **driving under the influence(DUI) investigations** and will cover the various aspects of alcohol and drug induced impaired driving. Along with familiarizing the student with impaired driving investigation protocol, participants will learn common examples of judicial, scientific, illegal narcotic and street slang terminology used by law enforcement, citizens and suspects involved in these types of investigations.

This course is designed to educate the Interpreter with terminology and impaired driving investigation protocol present in courtroom proceedings and department of motor vehicle (DMV) administrative hearings. Furthermore, this class will include explanative dialogue regarding specific and related terminology involving testimony from DUI investigation experts, medical experts, and other entities associated with driving under the influence (DUI) investigation and protocol. Emphasis will be made in improving the ability to convey meaning of terms and phrases needed for accurate interpretation into the desired target language.
