## **RecoveryWerks Is Starting an Adolescent Intensive Outpatient Program – Launching This Fall**

We're excited to announce that, with generous support from the McKenna Foundation, **RecoveryWerks! is launching a brand-new Intensive Outpatient Program (IOP)** specifically designed for adolescents navigating substance use

challenges. This groundbreaking program is the **first of its kind in Comal County**—and we couldn't be more excited to bring this vital resource to our community!

Our **structured, youth-focused IOP** offers personalized recovery treatment plans tailored to meet each

participant's unique needs. During this pilot phase, adolescents will benefit from **up to 9 hours per week** of comprehensive services including **educational sessions, one-on-one counseling/coaching, and group therapy.**

This is a **private pay, fee-based program**, with costs based on the level of services provided.

## RecoveryWerks Christmas Market – Calling All Vendors!

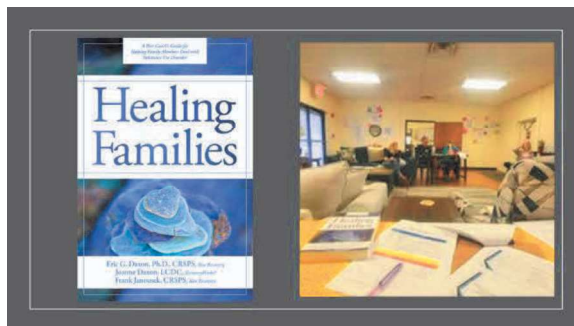


It is that time of the year again – time to get ready for the RecoveryWerks! Annual Christmas Market!
