

MAYME I. MORDEN

1917 - 1991

Mayme Ilene Morden, age 74 of Bad Axe, passed away Monday, Sept. 9 at Scheurer Hospital, Pigeon, of injuries suffered in an automobile accident.

She was born March 11, 1917 in Kinde, daughter of the late William A. and Edith Mary (Maynard) Seale.

She and Earl B. Morden were married Jan. 21, 1942 in Kinde. He preceded her in death on June 19, 1972.

Mrs. Morden was a graduate of Kinde High School and a 1936 graduate of Central Michigan University, Mt. Pleasant, where she earned a master's degree in English.

She began her teaching career in Shepherd and later returned to Kinde to teach. She later became principal of the school. Mrs. Morden and her husband founded the Huron County Abstract Co. and the Huron County Credit Bureau. She retired in 1985.

She was a member of St. Paul's Episcopal Church, Bad Axe and served on the corporate board for Huron Memorial Hospital, Bad Axe. Mrs. Morden was president of the Bad Axe Public Library Board and a member of the American Association of University Women. She was past president of the Bad Axe Board of Education and a member of the Sand Point Association.

Surviving are one daughter, Dr. Mary L. Morden, Baltimore, Md.; two sons, Charles B. Morden, Pigeon and Dr. Robert S. Morden, Birmingham and six grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by three brothers, Keith Seale, Robert Seale and Edward Seale.

Funeral services were held Thursday, Sept. 12 at St. Paul's Episcopal Church. The Rev. Ellen C. Rutherford, pastor, and other priests officiated with burial in the Colfax Township Cemetery. MacAlpine Funeral Home, Bad Axe, was in charge of funeral arrangements.
