Vineyard and Terroir

- Location: Right Bank of the Garonne River, and Entre-Deux-Mers region, Bordeaux
- Soil Type: Clay-limestone soils on slopes and "boulbène" soils
- Viticulture Practices: Sustainable farming practices are employed, with strict adherence to a Charter of Quality that governs all aspects of viticulture, ensuring the health and vitality of the vines.



Winemaking

- Harvest: Grapes are selected from the best plots before harvesting.
 90% of the picking is done by machine, ensuring maximum ripeness.
 Grapes are sorted to ensure only the healthiest and ripest are used.
- Vinification: The wine undergoes traditional vinification, starting with destalking and transfer into vats. Fermentation is temperature-controlled between 30° and 32°C for optimal extraction. Post-fermentation, the skins are pressed in a pneumatic press to maximize the extraction of ripe and soft tannins. Malolactic fermentation is carried out in vats.
- Aging: The wine is aged to enhance its complexity and structure, with a
 focus on preserving the balance and freshness of the fruit.





Tasting Notes

- Appearance: Deep red color with brilliant, elegant purple hints.
- Aroma: Expressive bouquet of red fruits, with notes of toast and vanilla.
- Palate: Unctuous and fleshy, with precise fruit fullness and harmonious tannins.
- **Finish:** Fresh, balanced, and delicate, with a lingering finish enhanced by controlled wood aging.
