SUMMER RULES

<u>\$100.00 sponsor fee</u> <u>\$80.00 Player fee</u>

1) 8 person team with an open roster.

2) There must be 25'6" between the front of the board to the front of the opposite board.

3) First team to 21 wins.

4) Scoring:

-Bag on top of board is 1 point

-Bag in hole is 3 points

-Bag on the ground is 0 points

-Points cancel each other out

5) Home team throws first at the beginning of all games. Throwing is alternated after the start.

The team that scores will go first the next throw. If the score ends in a wash then the team that threw last throws first.

6) The HOME team has first choice of what side of the board they shoot from. The visiting team can shoot from the other side or alternate throws with the home team on the same side. Once a side is chosen, players have to finish that set of throws before switching sides.

7) Each player will play four games per night as a two-person team. Please follow the score sheet. No player can play more than the four games.

8) All players must have their feet behind the line of the board before throwing the bag. A 3ft X 4ft area parallel to the board is the pitchers box. The toss must come from inside this area. If a foot foul occurs that player loses that throw. The foul must be called immediately after that throw.

9) Outside interference rule- If an outside interference occurs, play stops immediately. Both captains need to agree to the interference. If agreed the throw is re-done no matter what the outcome of the throw was.10) 5 second rule- After the last bag is thrown you must wait 5 seconds to give the bag a chance to fall. If after

5 seconds the bag did not fall and has stopped moving, you may pick up the bag. You may not physically disturb the board in any way during this time period. If you jump up and down, stomp your feet or touch the board in any way at any point during the inning ALL of your bags will be considered foul bags and your points will be forfeited from that throw.

11) Courtesy Drinks. Each player is allowed one courtesy drink per night compliments of the Home Teams bar. Courtesy drinks will be distributed **<u>Before</u>** the start of the 4<sup>th</sup> round, drinks not to exceed \$4.00.

12) The league begins at 7p.m. If either team is not ready for play by 7:15p.m. then that team forfeits that night and the remaining team receives 16 points. If at least 4 people are present, then play can start. The missing player's points are then forfeited, and points are given to the other team. Please work together to make the evening run smoothly.

13) Handicap Scoring- The handicap scoring will begin on the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of play

- Places 1-4 receive 0 points
- Places 5-9 receive 2 points
- Places 10-14 receive 4 points
- Places 15-18 receive 6 points
- Places 19-22 receive 8 points

14) All play within your group will start all games at 0-0. To achieve the starting handicap, subtract the lower teams place handicap from the higher teams place handicap- Ex. 10<sup>th</sup> place team receives 6 pts and 5<sup>th</sup> place team receives 2pts (6-2) the 10<sup>th</sup> place team will start with 4 pts.

15) Standard bag size is 6in X 6in with the weight of 14-16 oz.

16) Scores need to be texted the night of play by 1 person only!!

17) The losing team will buy the winning team a drink in the  $1^{st}$  and  $3^{rd}$  round of play.

Drink not to exceed \$4.00.

18) Rain Delays- Unless severe weather and affecting all areas, light rain delays will not be called. It will be up to each team to communicate with each other to play, split 8/8, play inside or make up by the next week of play. If the game has just started and interrupted by weather, please communicate between both teams as how you want to proceed. You can split 8/8 or makeup by the next week. If games have already been played and wins/losses have been noted, please communicate between both teams if you want to split the remaining games or make up the unplayed games before the next week.

19) There will be one extra week added to the schedule (if needed) for makeup games. They will be played the week before position night.
