God is speaking to us about igniting His ways within us and we can only do that by removing the things that work against our relationship with Him. God wants to break into the world and He can only do this through you and me.

When people see you, they see Him. God wants to rule and He reigns when He is released into situations upon the earth and He does this through you. To allow His Spirit to work in our heart without restriction fans the flame as He becomes greater and we become less" (John 3:30).

Never place limits on how God can use you for when you pursue righteousness, faith, love or peace, you are fanning the flame within you (2 Timothy 2:22). Remember, each person makes a choice and then lives by the choices made. You either fan the flame within you or not.
