

DESCRIPTION: The particular design of this Colt Heritage/Pearson Cobra was only made one year—in 1964. The Heritage was Colt's top of the line target bow in 1964. During the years that Ben Pearson had the contract to make Colt branded bows, any Heritage models that didn't pass quality control were retained by Pearson and branded as the Pearson Cobra. This bow was considered a "second" because of a lengthy crack in the riser. This riser crack was twisted open & injected with bowyer's epoxy and clamped shut. The riser was then refinished. The limbs are in original condition, with some common "yellowing". This is still a great looking and performing recurve. Other than the repaired crack in the riser, the bow is in good shape. No delamination; limbs are straight. Beveled arrow shelf. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes. No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decals are in very good shape. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age.
