During the **Early Voting** period (**October 17th –November 1, 2018**) you will be able to vote in person for the November 6, 2018 Election at the following locations:

***Early voters should be prepared to show Federal or Tennessee State issued Photo ID with name and photo to vote**

(TCA § 2-7-112)

***Voters whose polling place is not assessable to the elderly or handicapped may also vote early during this period.**

***Any voter that registered by mail and has never voted must vote in person the first election after their registration.**

ABSENTEE VOTING BY MAIL (TCA § 2-6-202)(a)(3)

A person who wishes to vote by absentee by mail and meets the qualifications may **obtain an application in person, by fax, email (with a scanned signature) or by mail with a signature from the Meigs County Election Commission Office.** To inquire about the qualifications, contact the Meigs County Election Commission Office at (423) 334-5866 or e-mail:

meigscoelect@gmail.com. Absentee applications must be completed in full and returned no later than October 30, 2018. The voter's absentee ballot must be received by mail no later than 8:00 P.M. November 6, 2018 at the Meigs County Election Commission to eligible to be counted.

Last day to register to vote for this election is October 9, 2018

TOWN OF DECATUR MUNICIPAL ELECTION

Town of Decatur passed an Ordinance requiring Property Rights Voters **SHALL ONLY** vote by Absentee Ballot. Property Rights Voters have been mailed an application for their ballots. Those that are received will receive their ballot by mail.

Photo ID Requirements for All Voters

(TCA § 2-7-112 (a) (1))Tennessee state law requires all voters voting in person to present a Federal or a State of Tennessee issued photo ID. The ID must contain the voter's name and photograph.
