2019-20: A Year of Musical Enrichment!

The Harmony House is proud to present the **2019-20** annual student events, providing inspiration, accountability, and musical growth for the budding musician/artist.

- **“Sundaes on Saturday” (Saturday, July 27, 2019, 12-2 p.m.):** Our **Open House/Meet & Greet** features **FREE** ice cream sundaes, live music provided by our students and instructors, music-related games & activities, door prizes, “test an instrument” booth. Great for the rising 6th grade band/orchestra student and other music students (piano, guitar, woodwind, brass, strings, percussion). Bring a friend and enjoy this family-friendly free event.
- **Chapel:** Any student is invited to share a selection in Chapel, which meets Sundays at 10:00am in the Great Room. **FREE.** Contact Heidi to schedule a Sunday.
- **Christmas Recitals:** Recitals are held on Fridays and Saturdays in December 2019: 12/6, 12/7, 12/13, 12/14, 12/20, and 12/21. See instructor for day/time. Students learn one to three selections and perform in front of a small audience. Recitals are held onsite in either Skylight Hall (upstairs, bldg. 200) or the Great Room (bldg. 100). There is a \$24 participation fee per family for this event, payable by Saturday, November 30, covering the refreshments and other costs. All guests are welcome.
- **Festival (Saturday, February 1, 2020, time TBA):** Students memorize two selections and play in front of an adjudicator with the potential to earn up to five points annually. At 15, 30, 45, and 60 points the student earns a gold cup and plays in the gold cup recital (see below). There is a \$35 participation fee per student for Festival.
- **Conservatory/Festival Gold Cup/Senior Recital (Saturday, March 7, 2020, 12-3 p.m., Great Room):** Students are selected for the Conservatory by instructor recommendation and achieve the musical goals as stated in the conservatory handbook, playing once annually in the conservatory recital. This event also showcases our Festival gold cup recipients (see above) and high school seniors. **FREE** to all students and attendees.
- **“Scale-a-Thon” (Saturday, March 28, 2020, 1-3 p.m., Great Room):** Celebrating the mastery of the building blocks of music—scales, chords, and arpeggios—with musical games, ribbons & trophies, and refreshments. (Due date for Mastery Sheet & fee: Saturday, March 21, by Noon.) There is a \$24 participation fee per family for this event.
- **Big Shanty Festival:** This **FREE** event is held in our tent in downtown Kennesaw, traditionally the second or third Saturday and Sunday in April 2020, TBD. Students may sign up at the back entrance of bldg. 200 to play a five to ten minute music set, providing fun and festivity to the Big Shanty Festival.
- **Spring/May Recitals:** Recitals are held on Fridays and Saturdays in May 2020: 5/1, 5/2, 5/8, 5/9, 5/15, 5/16. See instructor for day/time. Students learn one to three selections and perform in front of a small audience. Recitals are held onsite in either Skylight Hall (upstairs, bldg. 200) or the Great Room (bldg. 100-A). There is a \$24 participation fee per family for this event, payable by Saturday, April 25. All guests are welcome.
