

**TOWN OF CLOVERDALE
ORDINANCE 1998-5**

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PENALTIES
FOR VIOLATIONS OF ORDINANCE 1996-9**

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Cloverdale has determined that Ordinance 1996-9 as to collection of fees for video machines and recreational devices did not establish penalties for violations; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Cloverdale has heretofore been authorized by I.C. 36-8-2-10 to regulate operations of businesses including the authority to collect fees; and

WHEREAS, each day of violation shall constitute a separate offense pursuant to I.C. 36-1-3-8; and

NOW THEREFORE be it ordained by the Town Board of the Town of Cloverdale that the fine for violation of Ordinance 1996-9, as amended, shall be \$25 per video game or recreational device not registered, if fees are paid within 90 days of the due date, paid through the violation Clerk, or \$50 per video game or recreational device not registered, if fees are paid after 90 days. If the Town of Cloverdale institutes an action through the Court for enforcement of this ordinance fines and penalties may be assessed not to exceed \$2500 per violation.

This Ordinance shall have full force and effect upon passage of the Cloverdale Town Board.
