Aloha Kakou,

Welcome to Lent, a time of quiet reflection, focusing on the betrayal and arrest, the torture and execution of Jesus, from the perspective of the resurrection. People smarter than me like to point out that how we understand the past is shaped by how we anticipate the future. And how we anticipate the future is shaped by how we make sense of the past. It is always changing, evolving. To put it in a spiritual context, how we understand the crucifixion of Jesus is shaped by how we understand future resurrection and how we understand resurrection is shaped by the Cross. It is another one of those paradoxes of life that I find so helpful in my everyday life of faith.

And all of that happens in the here and now. We live that past-future paradox in the present, the felt, lived, bodied, expressive, spontaneous present, in the Incarnate Now. The Danish sorta-Lutheran philosopher Soren Kierkegaard was fond of saying: Life can only be understood backwards; but it must be lived forwards. But enough of my philosophical ruminations.

We had a good turnout for Ash Wednesday. In-person church attendance has been steadily increasing. Catechism has revived with five students. Keiki Church is back between services. The Third Sunday potluck has been growing. Friday night AA and Al-Anon groups have returned to campus.

Many of you are saying you are coming to the Wednesday Lenten Soup Supper and Study. The fairly new parking lot is going to be resealed and the parking barriers moved back so that we can actually get into and out of the stalls without too much trouble. Garden beds are being rejuvenated and replanted. The offices are going to be refurbished so that we can have a weekday indoor/outdoor meeting space for adult study groups, task force meetings, etc. Much is happening.

Yes, Lent is a time for reflection that comes with renewal. I see signs of both in what we are presently about. So, as we look back on everything that has been disfigured and crucified these past few years, we do so from the perspective of resurrection promise that comes to us in Word and Sacrament. And as we live out the promise of resurrection here and now in the power of the Spirit, we do so out of the challenging and crucifying experiences of past three years of coronaviral crosses.

It's a paradox. It's how we cope and find our way about. It's how God's grace and faith in Christ Crucified sustain us.
