BOOTH SET UP:

On Friday, July 25th, we are requiring vendors to set up between 11am—7pm..

DIRECTIONS FOR FRIDAY SET UP:

From Hwy 70, at Big Springs Park in Downtown Bonanza, turn onto MAIN STREET. At that location, we will provide you with your booth number and directions to it as well as collect any fees that may still be owed. We ask that you park and unload as promptly as possible.

VENDOR BOOTH HOURS:

The Homemade Hobby Festival Hours are from 10 p.m. to 5 p.m. on Saturday. Please be courteous to other attendees as there are many vendors and lots of things going during event. We encourage people to set up first thing Saturday, since a lot of customers will start browsing early, usually around 8am.

BOOTH TEAR DOWN:

Please tear-down your booth anytime after 6pm Saturday

COORDINATING EVENTS:

In conjunction with the Homemade Hobby Festival, there will also be the morning parade at 10am that will kick off the event, The Chili Cook-off (tasting kits will be available for \$5), the Children's Art Festival, the Big Springs Show & Shine Car Show, kids activities, Children's Carnival, Town-wide garage sales, music, lots of great food including the Fire Department's Tri-tip lunch.
