DESCRIPTION: Most of the Early Bear Polars were heavier draw weights. This is a rare 33# one. This semi-recurve bow is made of hard Maple. When strung the string doesn't touch the limb, so it would qualify as a long bow in NFAA competitions. This reconditioned Polar has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. . The old "Bone White" tip overlays were missing and were replace with new ones. Overlays and tips are in great condition. The old leather grip was replace with a new buckskin one. Bow has no drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Some discoloration and wear of the red limbs (see pic on last page). Decals are in good shape. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age. This bow was put to a stress test (held at full draw for 16 hours to make sure the old glues still held and no stress cracks developed. Comes with a new rug rest and side plate, and a new string.
