## Town of Marble Ordinance Number 8 Series of 2015

AN ORDINANCE FIXING AND CERTIFYING THE MILL LEVY FOR THE TOWN OF MARBLE FOR THE 2016 FISCAL YEAR.

## WHEREAS:

- A. The Town of Marble is a statutory town organized pursuant to Colorado Law; C.R.S. §31-1-101 et seq.;
- B. By Ordinance No. 7, Series of 2015, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Marble, Colorado has adopted the Town of Marble Budget for the 2016 fiscal year, and has made appropriations for the 2016 fiscal year;
- C. The Board of Trustees desires to fix and certify a mill levy to be levied upon all taxable property within the Town of Marble, to provide sufficient funds to pay the proposed expenditures for the 2016 fiscal year;
- D. The assessed valuation of taxable property for the year 2015 in the Town of Marble as returned by the County Assessor of Gunnison 2015County, Colorado is \$3,558,830;
- E. The mill levy for the Town is presently 6.505 mills, and the Board of Trustees has determined that it is in the public interest to leave the present mill levy unchanged for the 2016 fiscal year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MARBLE, COLORADO THAT:

- 1. An Ad Valorem Tax shall be levied against all taxable property in the Town of Marble, Colorado, for the 2016 fiscal year;
- 2. For the purpose of meeting all general operating expenses of the Town of Marble during the 2016 fiscal year, the Ad Valorem Tax shall be levied at a rate of 6.505 mills.
- 3. That the Clerk is hereby directed to deliver the Certification of Tax Levies (Form DLG 70), with a copy of this ordinance, to the Board of County Commissioners of Gunnison County, Colorado, as certification, no later than December 15, 2015.
