

ORDINANCE 1989- 5

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A VIOLATIONS BUREAU AND SCHEDULE OF ORDINANCES SUBJECT TO ADMISSION OF VIOLATION WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF CLOVERDALE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Board of the Town of Cloverdale that:

1. Under the provisions of I.C. 33-6-3-1 et seq, as amended, there shall be established for the Town of Cloverdale a Violations Bureau. It is further provided that the Violations Clerk shall be the Town Clerk-Treasurer or his or her appointee.
2. The Violations Clerk may accept written appearances, waivers of denial, admissions of violations and payments of civil penalties of not more than \$50.00, a schedule of which shall be included herein. Moving traffic violations may not be enforced by this Ordinance.
3. That such civil penalties as shall be determined herein shall be paid to, receipted and accounted for, by the Violations Clerk as provided by the State Board of Accounts and pursuant to Statute 33-6-3 and following as amended.
4. The Violations Clerk may receive the civil penalty only if the said person waives the right to trial and enters an admission of the violation.
5. A person charged with a violation may exercise the right to trial by denying the violation before the Violations Clerk or entering a written denial with the Violations Clerk.
6. In event of a denial of violation or failure to satisfy the civil penalty assessed or the failure to admit or deny, the Violations Clerk shall report such fact to the Corporation Counsel for initiation of a court proceeding for the alleged ordinance violation.
7. An ordinance violation admitted hereunder does not constitute a judgment and an ordinance violations cost fee may not be collected.
8. The following schedule of ordinance violations shall be established hereunder to be collected as civil penalties by the Violations Clerk.
