55 Broadlinc Fiber Update

56 Mrs. Johnson and Ms. Roecks met with the director of Broadlinc, Ariane Schmidt. Ms. Schmidt said that a
57 group called Inland Cellular won the bid to connect the “middle mile” of fiber internet from Fairfield to north of
58 Freeman. Inland Cellular may not accept the bid, which would allow Spokane County’s Broadlinc to secure
59 the project. There will be more updates in the next couple of weeks. Ms. Schmidt said that, if the bid is
60 awarded to Broadlinc, Rockford and Freeman should see completion of the project this summer.
