TOMORROW IS VETERANS DAY. DID YOU KNOW THAT VETERANS DAY WAS ORIGINALLY KNOWN AS ARMISTICE DAY? ALTHOUGH WWI HAD OFFICIALLY ENDED, THE FIGHTING DID NOT CEASE UNTIL AN ARMISTICE WAS PUT INTO EFFECT ON THE 11TH HOUR OF THE 11TH DAY OF THE 11TH MONTH. IT LATER BECAME VETERANS DAY, A DAY TO HONOR ALL AMERICAN VETERANS.

THE THEME FOR VETERANS DAY 2021 IS CENTERED ON THE CENTENNIAL COMMEMORATION OF THE TOMB OF THE UNKNOWN SOLDIER. LOCATED AT ARLINGTON NATIONAL CEMETERY, THE TOMB WAS INITIALLY DEDICATED ON ARMISTICE DAY, NOVEMBER 11, 1921, WITH THE BURIAL OF AN UNKNOWN SERVICE MEMBER FROM WORLD WAR I.

HERE'S ANOTHER INTERESTING FACT. OF THE 21.8 MILLION VETERANS IN THE UNITED STATES, MORE THAN 1.3 MILLION SERVED DURING MULTIPLE WARS. HAPPY VETERANS DAY TO ALL WHO HAVE SERVED IN THE ARMED FORCES—THANK YOU FOR YOUR SERVICE!

THIS SATURDAY, WE REMEMBER THE SERVICE OF OUR LONG TIME STAFF MEMBER, RICH FRISCHKORN. HE SERVED HERE AT WRVM FROM NOVEMBER 1, 1999 – OCTOBER 28, 2021; 22 YEARS. YOU ARE INVITED TO JOIN US IN A 'CELEBRATION OF LIFE' THIS SATURDAY AT RIVERVIEW ALLIANCE CHURCH IN OCONTO FALLS. VISITATION HOURS ARE FROM 9:30 – 11:00 AM. THE SERVICE BEGINS AT 11:00 AM. A LUNCH WILL BE HELD FOLLOWING THE SERVICE AT THE CHURCH.

NOW THAT HE HAS GONE ON THE GLORY, YOU KNOW WHERE THAT LEAVES ME, RIGHT? BUT, I'M THE OLDEST BY ONLY 3 MONTHS. MAY GOD RICHLY BLESS YOU AS YOU SERVE HIM WITH YOUR PRAYERS AND SUPPORT OF THE WRVM RADIO MINISTRIES.
