### Misleading Finals

**Marshall (-8) beat Coastal Carolina 31-19.** However, Coastal had a 391-254 yard edge but were -3 in TO's. Marshall got a blocked FG return for a TD.

**Liberty (-16.5) beat Massachusetts 35-34 in OT.** Massachusetts missed a 43-yard FG on the final play of regulation and also an extra point in OT. UMass would then fire their head coach Don Brown a couple days later. Brown was 6-28.

**Clemson (-12) beat Pittsburgh 24-20.** However, Pitt had a 438-346 yard edge.

**Kansas (+2.5) upset BYU 17-13.** However, BYU had a 354-242 yard edge. BYU was intercepted at the Kansas 5-yard line. They fumbled a punt which led to a 1-play 3-yard TD drive. They were also stopped on downs at the Kansas 8.

**Arkansas State (+2.5) beat Georgia State 27-20.** However, Georgia State had a 419-358 yard edge.

**USF (+1) scored two defensive TD's** in their 59-24 win over Charlotte.

### Bad Beats

**Boise State (-14) beat San Jose State 42-21.** However, some San Jose State backers had the Spartans as high as +14.5 on game day (including VIP clients). San Jose State led 14-0 outright early and still led 21-14 in the middle of the third quarter. However, San Jose would fumble at the Boise 34, fumble at the Boise the 43, Boise got a 70-yard "Pick 6" and in the final minute, San Jose State had a first and goal at the Boise 2-yard line but came away with zero points.

**Notre Dame (-20.5) covered the closing line vs Virginia 35-14.** However, most of the week, the line was above 21. Notre Dame led Virginia 35-0 and did benefit from five UVA turnovers. However, ND also had a pair of TD's called back via penalty including a controversial penalty after a fake punt TD. After leading 35-0 in the third quarter, UVA scored a TD on fourth down. The key play in the drive was a 38-yard pass was ruled complete (it wasn't on replay but never got reviewed). ND would then get stopped on 4th and Goal at the Virginia 5-yard line. After a Virginia punt, ND missed a 36-yard FG that would have given them a 38-7 lead. UVA would then go 80 yards in 16 plays converting one 4th down. After a timeout with :24 left, UVA scored a TD on 3rd and goal to get the back-door cover for some.

**The total in the UCLA/Washington game was 47.** After a TD with 5:44 left in the game, Washington led 24-13. UCLA would get stopped on downs. Washington went for it on 4th and 1 from the UCLA 14-yard line. The Huskies got a pass interference penalty and then scored a TD to make it 31-13 with 1:54 left. UCLA then went 80 yards in 12 plays and scored a TD with :08 left to put the game over.

### Injuries/Personnel News

- Ball State fired head Mike Neu after nine seasons. The Cardinals are just 3-7 this season and just suffered another tough loss (51-48 in OT to Buffalo).
- Charlotte fired head coach Biff Poggi on Monday. Poggi went 6-16 in two seasons and TE's coach Tim Brewster will be the interim.
- FAU QB Tyriq Starks who started the season at 3rd string will start this week.
- FAU fired head coach Tom Herman who was 6-16 in two seasons and had gone 0-6 in AAC play this year. Chad Lunsford will be the interim coach. FAU is rehiring DC Roc Bellantoni who was fired by Tom Herman on November 10th.
- As of press-time it is unclear who will start at QB for Iowa this week. Cade McNamara's status is cloudy and Ferentz said on Tuesday if the game were tomorrow (Wednesday), Jackson Stratton would be the starter. Brendan Sullivan is out for the season after starting the last few games.
- Missouri QB Brady Cook is still dealing with a wrist injury but is probable.
- Ohio State starting center Seth McLaughlin is likely out for the season after suffering an Achilles injury in practice Tuesday.
- Oklahoma State QB Alan Bowman will start vs Texas Tech.
- Pittsburgh QB Eli Holstein is questionable this week.
- SMU WR Jake Bailey is unlikely to return in 2024.
- Temple fired head coach Stan Drayton after a win vs FAU. Drayton was just 9-25 in three seasons.
- Virginia Tech QB Kyron Drones and RB Bhayshul Tuten are both ? this week.
- Wake Forest QB Hank Bachmeier will start vs Miami after sitting out last week's second half loss to North Carolina.
- Wisconsin fired OC Phil Longo after two years.

## Games in Rotation Order

## HOME TEAM IN CAPS

### Wednesday, November 20th

**TOLEDO 26 Ohio 24.** MAC Championship implications with both teams near the top of the standings. Ohio has the better yards per play margin (+1.1 vs +0.6) and the better run game. Lean OVER.

**EASTERN MICHIGAN 28 Buffalo 27.** Buffalo has already clinched bowl eligibility while EMU is sitting on 5 wins. Buffalo has the better ypp margin (-0.6 vs -1.4) and the better run game. Lean OVER.

### Thursday, November 21st

**GEORGIA TECH 31 NC State 22.** Both teams come in off a bye. NC State is still sitting on 5 wins while GT clinched bowl eligibility in their last game, a thrilling win over Miami, FL. The Yellow Jackets saw the return of QB Haynes King in that game and he should be even healthier here. Our ratings lean GT but we don't see much value.

### Friday, November 22nd

**UTSA 36 Temple 21.** Temple beat FAU in OT last week but still proceeded to fire their head coach Stan Drayton. Their win total was only 3 this year and they have met expectation. UTSA is off their two best performances of the season beating Memphis and North Texas and need another win to get to a bowl. We don't see much value.

**MICHIGAN STATE 32 Purdue 17.** MSU needs to win their final two games to get to bowl eligibility. MSU is +0.1 in ypp margin despite a tough schedule while Purdue is -1.3. The Boilers are just 2-8 ATS failing to cover by 10.5 points per game this season. We like MSU.

**Unlv 33 SAN JOSE STATE 25.** Both teams are in the Top 25 in yards per play margin this season (UNLV +1.4 vs San Jose St +1.3) but UNLV has played the tougher schedule. San Jose St backers suffered one of the worst beats of the season last week (see page 1). Tough spot for UNLV traveling on a short week but our ratings lean with them.

### Saturday, November 23rd

**COASTAL CAROLINA 30 Georgia Southern 28.** Coastal is off a misleading loss to Marshall last week (see page 1) while Georgia Southern was upset by Troy. Coastal needs a win to get to bowl eligibility. They are +0.1 in ypp margin while Georgia Southern is -1.2 in ypp margin despite a 6-4 record.

**Smu 34 VIRGINIA 24.** Obviously, SMU is marching towards the ACC Championship game at 6-0 in conference play. They are +1.6 in ypp margin but are dealing with cluster injuries at the RB/Receiver positions. UVA had a misleading 35-14 loss vs ND last week (see bad beats on page 1). UVA is sitting on 5 wins but will be over-matched.

**LOUISVILLE 34 Pittsburgh 25.** Both teams come in off heart-breaking losses. Louisville blew a 2-TD lead in the final minutes as Stanford got a walk-off 52-yard FG after a questionable coaching decision and questionable penalty. Pitt saw Clemson QB Klubnik get a long TD run in the final two minutes. Both need a win to restore some vibes. Louisville is slightly better in ypp (+1.5 vs +1.4) but has played the tougher schedule as well. Lean OVER.

**JACKSONVILLE STATE 30 Sam Houston State 24.** The winner controls their destiny in the CUSA race. Jacksonville State has won 7 straight games after a 0-3 start. Sam Houston survived OT at Kennesaw State last week. We don't see much value at current.

**MIAMI, FL 43 Wake Forest 20.** Miami comes in off a bye after suffering their first loss of the season. The Hurricanes still control their destiny in the ACC race and sit at No. 3 in the CFB Playoff seedings. Wake QB Bachmeier is expected to play here after getting dinged up last week. We lean with Wake.

**Central Florida 31 WEST VIRGINIA 29.** Neal Brown could be in some trouble at West Virginia. The Mountaineers have lost 4 home games this year and the natives are getting restless. UCF has also had a disappointing 4-6 season. Statistically, they still rank No. 19 in ypp margin (+1.4) and No. 19 in ypp margin (+109.2). A lot of early week money on UCF but we haven't got to the window yet.

**Bowling Green 34 BALL STATE 23.** Ball State fired their head coach Mike Neu after last week's tough OT loss to Buffalo. If BG wins out, they are in the MAC Championship game. Ball State games are 8-1-1 to the OVER by an average of 13.2 ppg but we don't see much value.

**North Carolina 29 BOSTON COLLEGE 27.** BC is still sitting on 5 wins. They gave good effort in a cover at SMU last week and we thought the market downgraded them too much for QB Castellanos transferring (he was benched!). NC has won 3 straight and playing their best ball. Lean BC.

**Virginia Tech 25 DUKE 24.** The line is telling us that VT QB Drones and RB Tuten should play here despite their questionable status. Both teams are off a bye. VT needs a win for bowl eligibility. We're a little surprised the line has crossed the key 3. Lean Duke.

† **Kansas 29 Colorado 28.** @Arrowhead Stadium in Kansas City. While Colorado controls its destiny in the Big 12, Kansas is arguably playing the best ball of any team in the conference after back-to-back wins over Iowa State and BYU. The Jayhawks are 1-5 in one-possession games this year and are underrated in the markets (4-0 ATS run). Their two CB's of Bryant and Dotson should match up vs CU's high-powered pass attack led by the Heisman front-runner. We're calling for the outright upset.

**Ole Miss 32 FLORIDA 21.** Ole Miss comes in fresh off a bye after arguably the most impressive win any team has had in CFB this season (dominating Georgia). The Rebels should get back All-American WR Harris from injury. Yes, Florida upset LSU last week but the Gators four starters in the secondary all played 93 snaps and now face the Ole Miss offensive tempo. Rebels are No. 1 in ypp margin.

**OLD DOMINION 27 Marshall 26.** Marshall is better in ypp margin (+0.6 vs 0.0) but Old Dominion has played the much tougher schedule (No. 68 vs No. 120). ODU needs to win out to get to bowl eligibility while Marshall is looking to win the East Division. Like most ODU games, it should come down to the wire.

**SYRACUSE 34 Connecticut 20.** Not sure many had both teams entering this game at 7-3. UConn is off a bye and much better in ypp margin (+0.8 vs -0.5). However, the Orange have played the much tougher schedule (No. 57 vs No. 133). Syracuse is off a big outright upset win over Cal, their 4th of the season! How will they handle the favorite role? Our ratings like them.

**Charlotte 27 FLORIDA ATLANTIC 25.** This is going to be a tough handicap with both schools firing the head coach this week in just their 2nd year on the job. FAU is better in ypp margin (-0.6 vs -1.1) but Charlotte has played the tougher schedule (No. 62 vs No. 105). FAU is starting a 3rd string QB but we still lean OVER.

**SOUTH FLORIDA 38 Tulsa 24.** We're not sure why the market hates Tulsa so much the last couple of weeks. Last week Tulsa was a 16.5-point underdog at home to East Carolina and nearly won outright. Earlier this season, they were +17.5 at home to Oklahoma State and +14 vs Army for comparison sake. They are just No. 124 in ypp margin. USF is off their best performance of the season, a blowout of Charlotte and need a win to get to bowl eligibility.

**James Madison 32 APPALACHIAN STATE 26.** JMU is much better in ypp margin (+11.2 vs -0.8) but Appalachian State has played the much tougher schedule (No. 81 vs No. 129). App State has won both home games since Boone, NC was devastated by the flooding and this should be an emotional Senior Day.

**NEBRASKA 21 Wisconsin 20.** Both teams are 5-5 and there aren't many more important games than this one on Saturday in relative to what a win or loss will do to the fan bases. Wisconsin is +0.0 in ypp margin (Nebraska -0.1) and the Badgers have played the tougher schedule (No. 11 vs No. 47). Can Nebraska win a close game? We lean with the road team.

**Penn State 28 MINNESOTA 17.** Minnesota has been one of the more run-heavy teams in CFB in recent years running it nearly 2/3 of the time. This season they are throwing it 53% of the time with QB Brosmer. Not sure if that is a recipe for success here if Penn State is able to shut down their run game as Minny has their worst rushing offense in 15 years. Penn St is heading towards a home playoff game.

**Iowa 25 MARYLAND 20.** Iowa might be down to a 3rd string QB in Jackson Stratton here with Sullivan out for the season and McNamara still banged up. The Hawkeyes are +0.8 in ypp margin while 4-6 Maryland is -0.1. We lean home team if the line ever gets to "+7".

**OHIO STATE 31 Indiana 18.** 10-0 Indiana comes in off a bye as the Hoosiers are No. 1 in scoring margin this year. However, they have played the No. 77 schedule. In their last game vs Michigan, they played tight and struggled vs the talented Michigan defense. Ohio State is better across the board but did suffer another injury to their OL as center McLaughlin injured his Achilles in practice on Tuesday. We think OSU is the right side, but we're passing at current.

**RUTGERS 24 Illinois 23.** Illinois really surprised us in their 38-16 win over Michigan State last week as we thought the Spartans were live in that game. Rutgers has pulled back-to-back upsets to get to bowl eligibility. Illinois is better in ypp margin (+0.0 vs -0.5) but we lean with the home team.

**MICHIGAN 27 Northwestern 14.** Michigan comes in off the bye needing a win to get to bowl eligibility and they will likely be 3-TD underdogs at Ohio State next week. Northwestern just gave a solid effort vs OSU but lost 31-7. A lot of early week money has come in on Northwestern but we lean with UM and the OVER here.

**GEORGIA 49 Massachusetts 6.** UGA got the big win vs Tennessee last week and should be in the playoffs if they win out. Our ratings love them here. However, the Bulldogs have covered in big games vs Clemson, Texas and Tennessee this year but have not handled these games well. UMass fired their head coach after a near huge upset of Liberty. How will they react?

**Western Kentucky 28 LIBERTY 27.** We don't like this Liberty team this year as they are 2-7 ATS failing to cover by 11.2 points per game. They are better in ypp margin than WKU who is off their worst performance of the season, a 12-7 upset loss to Louisiana Tech.

**TENNESSEE 49 Utep 7.** How motivated will Tennessee be here after putting it all on the line at Georgia last week and coming up short? Head coach Heupel is not afraid to run it up (see games vs Chattanooga and Kent State this year) but this UT offense has been struggling.

**Iowa State 25 UTAH 19.** This could be the final home game for Kyle Whittingham. It's been a miserable season as the Utes enter the game losers of 6 straight (1-5 ATS). They are banged up and were blown out by Colorado last week. Iowa State got a bounce back win vs Cincinnati last week but we don't want to lay more than a TD.

**UTAH STATE 32 San Diego State 28.** Utah State had one of the more shocking finals of the entire CFB season last week. They beat Hawaii 55-10 as 2.5-point home underdogs. They are better in ypp margin (-0.3 vs -0.8) and have played the tougher schedule than San Diego State. Let's see how they handle the favorite role.

**ARIZONA STATE 26 Byu 23.** We were thinking Arizona State might be one of our favorite plays of the week. However, the value got lost by last week's results. BYU lost their first game of the season to Kansas (Cougars did control the box score, see page 1) while Arizona State shocked Kansas State. BYU is the better team in the stats (+1.2 vs +0.7). We're passing.

**MIDDLE TENNESSEE 28 New Mexico State 25.** MT is better in ypp margin (-1.2 vs -2.0) and is coming off a bye while NMSt played physical Texas A&M last week. Tough laying points with a bad defense though. Pass.

**CALIFORNIA 34 Stanford 19.** The Big Game got a little more interesting after Stanford pulled one of the biggest upsets of the CFB season last week 38-35 vs No. 19 Louisville as 21-point underdogs. Speaking of upsets, Cal was upset as 10.5-point home favorites vs Syracuse last week. They need a win to get to bowl eligibility. We bet Cal.

**NEVADA 25 Air Force 20.** After starting the season 0-7 ATS, Air Force has covered 3 straight games. Last week they crushed Oregon State 28-0 as 3-point underdogs and the market seems to love them this week. We like Nevada coming in off a bye. Nevada is +0.0 in ypp margin while Air Force is -1.6. Nevada has played the tougher schedule (No. 73 vs No. 98). We disagree with the market move.

**Fiu 27 KENNESAW STATE 19.** It's safe to say the market overreacted to the Kennesaw news a week ago. They fired their coach and 20-plus players hit the transfer portal including 10 starters. Kennesaw went from 14-point to 21-point underdogs. The problem is despite being in the portal, most of the players still played and they lost in OT to Sam Houston State. The market has barely moved this week. FIU is better in the stats (+0.3 ypp vs -2.0) but we're not involved.

**UL-LAFAYETTE 33 Troy 20.** ULL not only lost to South Alabama last week as TD-favorites, they also lost QB Ben Wooldridge to injury. Chandler Fields does have plenty of experience in his career and we thought the market downgraded ULL too much. Troy is off back-to-back upsets but we don't see a 3rd straight here.

**Tcu 33 ARIZONA 24.** TCU comes in off a bye. The Horned Frogs are much better in ypp margin (+1.3 vs -0.2) but Arizona is off their best performance of the season (27-3 win over Houston). It was only their 2nd cover of the season, but we think they get a 3rd here.

**Missouri 31 MISSISSIPPI STATE 24.** Missouri got back QB Brady Cook last week and nearly pulled off a huge upset at South Carolina. They're taking on a Mississippi State team that is fresh off a bye. Mizou is better in the stats (+0.1 vs -0.7 in ypp margin) but Miss St has played the much tougher schedule (No. 10 vs No. 54). We're passing.

**South Alabama 38 SOUTHERN MISS 16.** We don't like using the "Q" word often but it sure looks like Southern Miss has quit. They have an interim coach and have been outscored 95-6 the last two games. South Alabama is off their biggest win of the season and needs one more to get to a bowl.

**KANSAS STATE 29 Cincinnati 21.** Both teams are struggling right now. Cincinnati has lost 3 straight. Kansas State has lost two straight. The Wildcats are much better in ypp margin (+1.2 vs +0.2) and have played the tougher schedule. However, it's tough trusting their offense laying more than a TD right now.

**TEXAS 34 Kentucky 14.** UK has been great as a big underdog as they are 3-0 ATS with an average cover of 15.3 ppg. They lost by 1 to Georgia as 21.5-point dogs, upset Ole Miss 20-17 as 15-point dogs, and lost by 10 at Tennessee as 17.5-point dogs. Texas has the No. 1 defense in the country but the offense has scored 27 or less in 3 of the last 4.

**Texas Tech 35 OKLAHOMA STATE 31.** Since a 3-0 start, Oklahoma St has lost 7 straight games (1-6 ATS) and is No. 121 in ypp margin. Texas Tech has had an up and down season but their defense is allowing 35.1 ppg (No. 122). Don't see much value here.

**NORTH TEXAS 37 East Carolina 34.** Should one of the fastest paced games this entire season. ECU runs the 2nd fastest tempo in the country while North Texas runs the 4th fastest. ECU has the better defense, NT has the better offense. We bet North Texas in the early markets but don't see much value now.

**TEXAS STATE 38 Georgia State 19.** Texas State is better than their 6-4 record indicates. They are No. 12 in ypp margin (+1.8), No. 11 in ypp margin (+142.6), No. 17 in scoring margin (+15.5) and have been favored in all 10 games so far. Georgia State has covered one game this season, the outright upset over Vanderbilt. The problem is Texas State hasn't always been buttoned up this year.

**Rice 31 UAB 23.** Rice is coming off a bye. Meanwhile, UAB is off a blowout loss to Memphis and we wonder if we're seeing the last game or two of the Trent Dilfer era. Rice should win the line of scrimmage as the Owls are +20 in sack margin while UAB is -13. We bet Rice.

**ARKANSAS 37 Louisiana Tech 14.** Obviously, Arkansas has played the much more difficult schedule (No. 12 vs No. 138). The Hogs are sitting at 5 wins and head coach Sam Pittman has had a hot seat all year. Louisiana Tech is fresh off their biggest win of the season and played NC State really tough earlier this year. Lean OVER.

**Texas A&M 24 AUBURN 23.** Auburn is the superior team in the stats as they are +2.0 in ypp margin (No. 10) and +123.7 in ypp margin (No. 13) vs Texas A&M who is +0.9 in ypp margin (No. 38) and +67.6 in ypp margin (No. 40). The difference is A&M is +4 in TO's while Auburn is -11. We would not be surprised with an outright upset here.

**Baylor 28 HOUSTON 21.** Baylor games have gone OVER in 7 straight by 17.3 ppg. Meanwhile, Houston games are 9-1 to the UNDER this year by 10.3 ppg. Correlation with favorite and OVER and dog and UNDER? We think so as we took Houston and UNDER.

**UL-Monroe 26 ARKANSAS STATE 25.** ULM's yards per play margin is 1.0 yard better than Arkansas State despite playing a tougher schedule (No. 70 vs No. 93). Arkansas State is sitting fat and happy after clinching bowl eligibility last week. The Red Wolves are a phony team with a 5-0 record in one-possession games. Meanwhile, ULM has been sitting on 5 wins for over a month. They've lost 4 straight games albeit all to better teams than Arkansas State in South Alabama, Marshall, Texas State and Auburn. ULM outright.

**Usc 27 UCLA 23.** While it is just across town, it should be noted that USC is 0-4 SU and 0-4 ATS in true road games this year despite being favored in all 4 games! Both teams need a win for bowl eligibility (USC at 5 with ND on deck, UCLA at 4 with Fresno on deck). USC got a big win over Nebraska last week while UCLA lost in Seattle on Friday night. Obviously, major story line with new USC DC Lynn being the UCLA DC last year. USC is better in the stats but we lean UCLA.

**LSU 30 Vanderbilt 23.** Vanderbilt is off a bye which came at the right time for a banged up QB Pavia. The Commodores are 6-1 ATS as underdogs this year with 4 outright upsets. They're taking on a reeling LSU team that has lost 3 straight and nothing to play for except pride.

**Boise State 39 WYOMING 17.** Boise State backers got an extremely fortunate cover last week at San Jose State (see page 1). Wyoming had been playing better as of late but were handled by rival Colorado State.

**Washington State 35 OREGON STATE 22.** Oregon State has been a dumpster fire this season. The Beavers are 2-8 ATS and are losing outright to teams like Nevada, San Jose State and Air Force. This was a team ranked as high as No. 10 last year in the middle of November.

† **Notre Dame 31 Army 14.** @Yankee Stadium. Army has not played a single team in the Top 90 of our power ratings. They are off a bye but had a misleading 14-3 win over North Texas prior. ND already faced the option and paced with flying colors vs Navy. More of the same.

**Alabama 31 OKLAHOMA 17.** Alabama comes in off a win over FCS Mercer while Oklahoma had a bye last week. Oklahoma is sitting on 5 wins while Alabama owns most of the SEC tie-breakers to get to the SEC Championship game. Bama's offense rolls here.

**FRESNO STATE 25 Colorado State 24.** Colorado State has covered 7 straight games and can make the Mountain West Championship game if they win out. Meanwhile, Fresno State is off a bye and is sitting at 5 wins. We lean Rams.



# Week 13 Computer Projected Lines for Every CFB Game

For the past eight seasons we have posted computer projected lines for every game on Wednesday. **Games where there was of difference of more than 3 points saw our computer lines actually beat the Vegas line at a 487-414-14 (54.1%) clip!** That's pretty solid and actually better than our own handicapping in some seasons. Keep in mind, these computer lines don't take into consideration off-the-field factors like revenge or flat spots or if there are late-week injuries. They are basically a power-rating number difference between the two teams that also takes into consideration the home field advantage.

**This year's record is 17-22 so far.** Of the 3 games where our computer is off more than 3 points compared to the Vegas line (highlighted), our favorite team this week to back would be **Michigan -10.5**.

The Comp column is the computer projected line and the Diff column is the difference between the Vegas line and the Computer line. "+" numbers in the difference column say back the underdog. "-" numbers in the difference column say back the favorite. Let us know if you have questions.

We think it's the best value bets we make all week. 2020 was the first season where we tracked every single bet we made and posted them in the weekly newsletters. We were very pleased with our 119-76-3 (61%) record on these Sunday bets with an average line value of 2.6 ppg! In 2021, we were 224-196-5 (53.3%) vs the Circa openers with an average line value of 1.8 ppg. In 2022, we were 314-262-14 (54.5%, CLV 417-122-51 +1.65 ppg). **Pittsburgh 20 CLEVELAND 15.** There couldn't be two more polar opposite franchises in the NFL and they're only 130 miles apart. The Steelers, a franchise of winning and stability vs The Browns, a franchise of losing and instability. The Steelers have vastly overachieved this year and lead the AFC North at 8-2. Their season win total was 8. Meanwhile, the Browns are in dead last at 2-8. Their season win total was 8.5. The Browns rank dead last in ypp margin and DVOA. More of the same here as we lean Pittsburgh.

**Sunday, November 24th**

**Detroit 28 INDIANAPOLIS 20.** Detroit sits at 9-1 for the first time since 1954. Last week's 52-6 win over Jacksonville was the largest margin of victory ever for Detroit and the 475-yard margin was the 3rd largest in NFL history. The Lions are 8-2 ATS and have covered 70% of their games since Dan Campbell took over. They rank No. 1 in DVOA. Indianapolis has overachieved this year at 8-3 ATS. They are -0.2 in ypp margin. The Lions are probably a good teaser option getting them down to -1.5.

**Kansas City 26 CAROLINA 17.** The Chiefs winning streak is finally over as the favored Bills beat them 30-21 last Sunday. KC is only +0.1 in ypp margin and should probably have multiple losses. Meanwhile, Carolina comes in off a bye. The Panthers won and covered their two games prior to the bye. While they are 0-2 ATS as a double-digit underdog this year, we think they cover here vs a KC team that just had their "dream crusher" so to speak.

**Minnesota 21 CHICAGO 17.** The Bears somehow, somehow found another way to lose to Green Bay on Sunday, this time getting their game-winning FG blocked on the final play. That's 11 straight losses for them vs the Packers, the longest streak in the storied history. Chicago is -1.1 in ypp margin (No. 31) while the Vikings are 8-2 SU and 7-3 ATS with a +0.4 ypp margin. (No. 8). The two teams are a combined 14-6 to the UNDER this year. We lean Vikings and UNDER.

**WASHINGTON 27 Dallas 17.** The Cowboys season is not the only thing collapsing as part of the AT&T roof came down last Monday. Dallas was blown out by Houston and are only 2-8 ATS on the season now. Meanwhile, Washington has a couple of extra days to prep after losing to the Eagles last Thursday. Washington is No. 9 in ypp margin, Dallas No. 29. Not sure we can trust the rookie QB Daniels yet to lay double-digits but we certainly can't trust Dallas.

**Tampa Bay 21 N.Y. GIANTS 16.** Obviously, the Giants are a joke right now at 2-8 SU and 3-7 ATS and are -0.8 in ypp margin. They have benched QB Daniel Jones and are expected to turn to Tommy DeVito. Jones went 3-13 in 16 starts since signing a 4-year \$160 million deal last March. They're off a bye but so is their opponent Tampa Bay who has shown way more life (-0.1 ypp margin) this season. Maybe the Giants get a one-game bump with DeVito but we prefer the UNDER here which is 7-3 in Giants games.

**MIAMI 28 New England 19.** Don't look now but the Dolphins have covered 3 straight and won 2 straight. Remember the offense averaged just 10 ppg in the 4 games without Tua so there could be some value with their full-season stats. New England has also been playing better as of late with 3 covers in their last 4 games. We like the Dolphins

That might be one of the reasons they are a league-worst 1-9 ATS as the pros continue to bet them considering their average stats. Houston is off the MNF blowout win over Dallas. The Texans are No. 10 in YPP and No. 11 in DVOA. We think they would make for a good teaser option down to -2.5.

**Denver 24 LAS VEGAS 20.** The Broncos have far exceeded expectations this year at 6-5 SU and 8-3 ATS. That includes a blowout win over the Falcons last Sunday. Denver is a respectable No. 6 in ypp margin and No. 10 in DVOA. The same can't be said for the Raiders who are 2-8 SU and likely back in the head coaching market again next season (they already fired their OC). We lean OVER which is 7-3 in Las Vegas games this year.

**Arizona 24 SEATTLE 23.** Everybody is in the mix in the NFC West. Arizona leads the way at 6-4 while the Rams, Seahawks and 49ers are all just one game back. The Cardinals are legit as they are +0.5 in yards per play margin despite playing the toughest schedule in the NFL according to Jeff Sagarin. Seattle got the upset win over San Francisco last week to stop a 1-5 ATS slide. We lean with the Cardinals off the bye here.

**San Francisco 24 GREEN BAY 23.** Somehow the 49ers are 5-5 SU despite being favored in all 10 games this season. Yes, we know they have been banged up but HC Shanahan has done a poor job this season. Statistically, they rank No. 2 in yards per play margin at +1.3. Green Bay is No. 4 in ypp margin at +1.0. The Packers are coming off the thrilling win over the Bears. We like the spot here for the 49ers who are in desperation mode. We like them outright and love them in a teaser up to +8.5.

**Philadelphia 26 L.A. RAMS 24.** The Eagles have extra time to prep after beating the Commanders on Thursday. Philly is No. 3 in ypp margin (+1.1). The Rams are 5-5 but are -0.2 in ypp margin. They have played a much tougher schedule (No. 9 vs No. 29). Eagles fans should make up a good portion of the crowd but we don't see much value here.

**Baltimore 26 L.A. CHARGERS 22.** One of the bigger games of the regular season with the Harbaugh brothers meeting again. They met in 2011 in the regular season and later in Super Bowl 47. John's Ravens won both matchups over Jim's 49ers. The spot screams Baltimore here after a tough loss to the Steelers on Sunday where kicker Tucker missed multiple FG's. Meanwhile, you can sell the Chargers "high" off 4 straight wins including a thriller over the Bengals on SNF. Baltimore is much better in the stats at +1.5 in yards per play margin (No. 1) while L.A. is +0.3. Baltimore has also played the tougher schedule (Chargers have played the weakest so far). We lean Baltimore and UNDER.
