What is a Backtrack to a Throwback?

It's the theme for the 36^{th} VASARDA/VASCA Virginia State Convention on February 19, 20, & 21, 2026.

We are throwing back to the 60's, 70's, 80's and 90's. Pack all your favorite outfits and come join the fun. We will be at the Holiday Inn Virginia Beach-Norfolk Hotel and Conference Center, 5655 Greenwich Road, Virginia Beach, VA 23462.

The Convention Programs will include Social Square Dancing (SSD), Mainstream, Plus, Plus DBD, Advance, Rounds Phase 2-5, Line Dancing, Contra and Clogging. There will also be Square Dance workshops, Intro's and Round Teaches. For all the Round Dancers there will be a Rounds Showcase. The dancing starts on Thursday evening. Friday starts the first full day of dancing, from morning workshops to a Mainstream Diehard for everyone to enjoy. The dancing will continue Saturday morning and closing ceremonies will be on Saturday night. This year there will be a Dangle Hour sometime during the convention so be sure to mark that on your schedule. There will also be an educational Seminar for you to hear from one of the callers.

The convention uses multiple ballrooms so there is always something for everyone to try during the convention. The round dance room will have flooring put down over the carpet. The other ballrooms may or may not have flooring covering the carpet. If you have dance socks to put over your shoes that helps with dancing on the carpet.

To help cover some of the cost to put on the convention we will continue to have the 50/50 drawing each night. You do not need to be present to win. We will also have the clothing sale. You might find something wild to wear during this convention. We also will be having raffle baskets. We ask each region to donate a basket to be raffled off. I did not receive a question this quarter so I decided to share some information about Callerlab. Jeremy and I recently returned from the Callerlab convention which is hosted each spring. The convention is an opportunity for callers from around the world to come together, share ideas and conduct some business in the many committees which function within Callerlab. From a dancer perspective, what is there to know about Callerlab?

Callerlab is the international association of square dance callers and has a large role in managing the nuts and bolts of our activity. Callerlab allows callers to acquire music licensure to ensure they can play the music we dance to. But, a great deal of their time is spent managing the dance level lists, providing resources to new callers, and amending definitions and teaching documents. The definitions you learn in lessons, the level which you use to identify where you can dance all of this comes from Callerlab.

In addition to the standardization practices, Callerlab also has a foundation which is dedicated to the promotion of square dancing. The foundation recently launched a full publicity campaign creating advertising materials to promote square dancing. The results are great items that clubs can use when starting lessons or for general promotion! Ultimately, Callerlab is not just for callers. It is an organization aimed at keeping our activity alive and well! I encourage you to take a trip over to their website and peruse the wealth of information available, https://callerlab.org/ if you are attending the National Convention, wander on over to their vendor booth and meet some folks from the home office! Callerlab is a great organization to assist in bridging the gap between caller knowledge and dancer knowledge.

Tuckahoe Square Dance Club had a great opportunity this year to partner with well-known Arizona caller, Mike Sikorsky, for a Plus level Zoom class. Twenty studentsc ompleted 16 hours of instruction with Mike and learned the 29 calls on the CallerLab Plus list. The feedback from the students was so positive the club followed up with a Friday night Zoom dance in March with Mike calling from Arizona. We plan to host more Zoom dances with Mike as our calendars align. We see the Zoom platform as a pathway to embrace technology and eliminate geographic boundaries. We hope to partner with other national callers in the future.

How the Idea Became a Reality -

Our club Co-President, Patty Mason attended a dance in Fluvanna called by Mike Sikorsky in October 2024 and asked him was he able and interested in teaching a Plus class via Zoom. Mike had prior experience using the Zoom platform and said yes, so we decided to research using Zoom technology.

Thanking our Lucky Stars -

Our club dance venue, All Saints Episcopal Church, had recently upgraded their Audio/Visual (AV) system in the community hall and they allowed the club to use it for the Zoom class. We scheduled 3 test sessions with Mike and created a workable class experience for our students.

The Nuts and Bolts -

In addition to the venue giving us access to a fast bandwidth Wi-Fi connection, the new AV system is a state-of-the-art ceiling mounted Panasonic video projector that is tied into 10 ceiling mounted speakers. The video projects onto a large drop-down projector screen in the front of the hall. A standard HDMI cable was connected from the club laptop to the wall mounted HDMI port for the AV system. For the laptop audio, we added the Logitech Blue Yeti USB multi-pattern microphone (~\$95.99) to eliminate any microphone feedback from the dancers, music, and caller's voice in the room. This mic also made it easy for the students to speak with the caller. For the video we used a Nikon (DSLR) digital camera on a tripod. By placing the camera on a tripod and then on a table we were able to get a large format view of the dance floor for Mike to see over Zoom. In our initial equipment testing we had some video delay issues with the camera connection. We added a device between the laptop and camera called a CAM Link 4K (~\$99.00 from elgato.com). This device easily connects a DSLR camera, camcorder, or other action camera to your PC or MAC making it a "webcam" for the Zoom session. This device removed buffering issues for smooth video capture.

Tuckahoe Square Dance Club Richmond, Virginia

Ready to Dance -

To start class each week, our club tech:

- 1. Connected laptop to the local Wi-Fi
- 2. Connect HDMI cable from the laptop to the HDMI wall port which establishes the connection to the AV system: ceiling mounted video projector and the in-house speakers.
- 3. Connect USB microphone to the laptop using standard USB port on laptop.
- 4. Set up the camera on tripod and connect it to the laptop with a second HDMI cable and the CAM Link 4k.
- 5. Camera may need a supplemental power source depending on the size and lifespan of camera batteries. If needed plug in power source now.
- 6. Raise tripod and camera to full height and place in front corner of dance call.
- 7. Open free Zoom App on laptop (previously loaded on laptop).
- 8. Start a test Zoom meeting to check video connection and camera placement.
- 9. Adjust camera height and orientation to cover the maximum area of the dance floor. You may need to place tripod/camera on table to reach desired height.
- 10. Accept Zoom invite from caller 15 minutes before class or dance.
- 11. Complete sound checks with caller.

Once the Zoom session was established, a sound check was conducted in the dance hall with the students quietly assembled in squares. During the sound check first work with the caller to adjust the mix of the music to his vocals. Caller can adjust the mix so that one does not overpower the other. Secondly, the volume on the AV system was adjusted for the room. Having the dancers in squares aligned under the speakers facilitated the sound check and guaranteed all the dancers could hear both the music and caller vocals.

Caller Do's and Don'ts by Mike Sikorsky -

- 1. The caller must have a paid Zoom account to prevent the session from timing out.
- 2. Caller should click into Zoom settings and enable the live music Beta feature and leave it turned off.
- 3. Next the caller should click on the arrow next to the blue share button at the center of the bottom of the screen.
- 4. Look at the tabs at the top of the screen and click on Advanced.
- 5. Click on share computer audio.
- 6. Click the share button at the bottom center of the screen.
- 7. Plug in a USB microphone.
- 8. Put on headphones.
- 9. Send an email invite to the person who is going to help you test the Zoom connection.
- 10. Start playing music on Square View.
- 11. When the person accepts, an alert will come up to the top of the screen and the caller should click yes and allow them admittance to the session.
- 12. The receiving end will need to have a way of broadcasting the sound so all the dancers can hear, and they will also need a camera that is elevated so the caller can see all the dancers.
- 13. The caller should have patter music playing and then should start calling so the receiving end can test the sound balance between voice and music.
- 14. The caller may need to turn down the music volume and will need to use the volume slide in Square View to do it.
- 15. The caller should remember to mute their mic and possibly mute their video camera during breaks.

2 exhibition groups to put unique dance styles on display at the 74th NSDC

We know you will have a lot of opportunities for various types of dancing, workshops, and education classes while attending the 74th National Square Dance Convention® in Shreveport, LA, on June 25-28, 2025, but when you need a break or just to rest your feet come on over to the Shreveport Convention Center's Auditorium (Exhibit Hall 2) and watch the exhibition groups perform their routines. You will be treated to the unique dances of two groups, each putting their distinctive style of dancing on display - the California Heritage Dancers and River City Riders. The 74th NSDC's exhibition groups will be performing Thursday, June 26, and Friday, June 27. See the convention's daily schedules upon arrival for each performance group's days and times.

CALIFORNIA HERITAGE DANCERS

The California Heritage Dancers exhibition group anticipates doing three performances/programs at the 74th NSDC. One will be an hour-long program on the History of Square Dancing, another will be a historically accurate dance from the 1800s, and the third will be a dance specially adapted to fit the "Dance on the Wild Side" theme of the convention.

The California Heritage Dancers exhibition group has been performing since 1987; they will celebrate their 38th anniversary in October 2025. Their



performance venues have included more than 25 National Square Dance Conventions®, three Canadian Square Dance Festivals, many California State Square Dance Conventions, regional festivals, community events, and even a two-week performance tour in Austria. The dance troupe's purpose is to educate as well as entertain. By demonstrating the history of square dancing from its beginning here in the United States in the 1700s to modern times (1950s), they

hope to ignite in their audiences an appreciation of our national folk dance, according to group dance leaders.

Ruth Walker-Hagan, founder and original director, created the California Heritage Dancers to bring the square dance cultural heritage to the attention of the American public. Extensive research (pre-internet) has resulted in a series of dances performed with authentic period costuming, music, figures, and customs of the era. The ever-expanding repertoire

currently includes 10 core routines plus multiple adaptations and variations dating from the Colonial period up through the 1950s.

The dance troupe is dedicated to preserving the historic dances which have contributed to the worldwide movement of square dancing. This dance as we know it today originated in the United States, and like the people who have contributed to its development, is a product of the cultural "melting pot" which makes

our country great. The group is coming to the 74th NSDC primarily from Southern California, and all of them are members of regular square dance clubs in addition to the Heritage Dancers. For more information, visit: http://www.heritage.sdsda.org.

RIVER CITY RIDERS



The River City Riders (RCR) have galloped their way into your hearts at 12 national conventions, nine USA West Conventions, local festivals and many other events. According to lead riders, Jolene and Ed Cummings, the Oregon-based group originally formed in 2000 but were "corralled" for awhile before reorganizing in 2006. "Our club at that time was the River City Dancers. They put the idea together from what they saw at a county fair in Washington. Some guys with "horses" strapped on them were circulating

among the crowd. They went home and decided they could do this and perform with square dance moves!"

The caller for the River City Dancers in Milwaukie, OR, at that time was Les Seely, and he and wife, Paula, who now reside in Arizona, helped in the creation of the River City Riders. Five years ago, the reins of the organization were picked up by a new sponsor, the Country Cut-Ups located at the "Barn" the Country in Boring, OR.

The late Jim Hattrick served as a long-time group caller and created several programs over the course of 12 years, including a six-couple "Hex" routine, a four-couple dance sequence with A-1 moves called "Long Tall Texan," and the group's three-couple "Triride" that features six different music patterns.

"Each program has moves that fit together like a glove," Jolene Cummings noted. "Jim was a genius that shared his knowledge. We're so sad that he passed away in 2023, he is greatly missed, but the group continues to celebrate his life with each performance."

The River City Riders exhibition group now has a new caller standing by, to be announced soon, for the 74th NSDC. The horses will be making the long journey from Oregon to Shreveport via a special trailer pulled by the Cummings, along with a few fellow riders as passengers. The group's sturdy steeds are made from plastic barrels decorated by their riders to look like horses that the dancers step into and then hook onto a belt he or she is wearing. The horses can weigh between 25

to 30 pounds! These steeds have awesome riders that add their expertise to the program, including the RCR's lead riders, Jolene and Ed Cummings on Twilight and Mr. Ed, and then Danny and Carol Williamson riding Freedom and Hayburner, Young and Robert Lumsden on Callus and Choco, Ron Rasmussen riding Butterscotch and Lois Manos on Cocoa.

To fund the program, the group conducts garage sales, performs for Senior Citizen Centers and Square Dance Clubs, and accepts donations. Jolene Cummings said the money raised by the group goes toward transportation for the horses and the riders pay their own way.

"We look at it like it's our vacation," she stated. "So our fellow dancers, friends, and club members help finance this "horse" program and move the horses across the country for the 'trail

rides.' It's pretty awesome!"

One of the group's fun adventures on a previous "trail ride" was a stop in the Four Corners area where four states touch on the way to New Mexico. "The horses felt like galloping, so of course they did!" Ed Cummings added over the past 14 years the horses have traveled more than 70,000 miles, including all the way from Oregon to Georgia, performing for various conventions, clubs and events.






