- *Do you offer home delivery? Yes, to homebound, seniors age 65 & up . Call (330) 745-3693 by Tuesday at 5PM for delivery on Thursday.
- *How do I qualify for help? Live in Barberton, Norton, Doylestown, Clinton, or New Franklin with income within the State guidelines. For example: 1 person can earn \$495/wk, 2 people \$669, 4 people \$1,019 See www.BACM.org for complete financial guidelines.
- *What do I need to bring? Photo ID and proof of residency (such as piece of mail with name & address)
- *How can I donate food? Stop by BACM Mon-Thurs 9AM-12PM
