Winemaking

- Harvest: The grapes were harvested from September 23rd to October 5th, 2019. The weather during the harvest was ideal, with beneficial rainfalls that hydrated and stimulated the vines, resulting in well-balanced and concentrated grapes.
- Vinification: The wine underwent a traditional vinification process, with each varietal being fermented separately to preserve their individual characteristics before blending.
- Aging: Aged in oak barrels for 12-14 months, with 30-40% new oak, which adds complexity and structure to the wine.

- Appearance: Deep ruby color with a brilliant sheen.
- Aroma: An enticing bouquet of ripe red fruits, such as cherry and plum, with subtle hints of spice and cedar.
- Palate: Rich and rounded, the wine offers flavors of blackcurrant and blackberry, supported by fine tannins and a well-balanced acidity. The Petit Verdot adds a spicy touch, enhancing the complexity of the blend.
- Finish: Long and smooth, with a lingering finish that highlights the wine's fruitiness and harmonious structure.
